



From Monday 23rd March we have provided home learning on our school website including weekly grids for each stage and daily updates with other links and resources. From Monday 20th April all learning for P1 – P7 will be available via glow:

- Provision children will continue to access learning on Seesaw.
- P1 – P6 will use Microsoft Teams and access this on glow.
- P7 will use Google Classroom and access on glow.
- Additional links will be available on the 'Learning from Home' (previously called Snow Day) page on the website which will be updated every Monday morning.
- At least one member of staff from each stage will be available daily online although this may not be your child's current Teacher.
- Any member of our team who is supporting in the Hub will not be expected to be online on that day.
- We have listened to feedback from families and staff to create a balance of weekly tasks as we appreciate some of the constraints that families will be working under at this time. Some parents/carers working at home will be juggling the demands of their professional lives with the need to support young people in their learning. Some families have more than one child in the family and parents/carers will need to divide their time between all. Not all families will have immediate access to technology/software required to complete the tasks that have been set.
- The mental wellbeing of our young people is paramount at this time of great uncertainty. We must balance the need to support them to progress in their learning with arguably the greater need to keep them well, mentally as well as physically.
- Pupils will not be expected to complete work over the Easter holiday; however, pupils may wish to continue with some tasks that they enjoy to give them something to focus on. Resources will be on the school website to support this.
- Learning tasks should be balanced with the need for time to relax.
- It is important that all take the opportunity for daily exercise outdoors if they can.
- Numeracy and Literacy tasks will be available weekly from 9am every Monday.
- A fortnightly grid will also be available on glow from 9am every Monday.
