

## Dream Sandwich Money Task

What would your dream sandwich be? What ingredients would you put in your idea sandwich? Think about all your favourite things you could put into a sandwich and all of the ingredients you would need to make it. If you need some inspiration, here's a video that might help! (Adults at home - this is child friendly but other Taskmaster clips might not be!)

Your task is to dream up your perfect sandwich, make a list of what you will need and then using online supermarkets, get the prices of everything on your list and calculate how much you would need to spend to make the sandwich of your dreams! Please remember you are only looking at the prices of the things - **please don't spend any real money doing this!**

Remember we need to see all your working out and when you have finished, you could draw what you imagine it might look like 😊

**Remember when you're using money that £2 is 200p so if you're adding 80p + 84p + £2, it's not 80 + 84 + 2 ...**

**Challenge level 1:** We would like you to calculate how much your shopping would cost you for all the ingredients you'd need to buy.

**Challenge level 2:** If you want to go further, try to work out the cost of one sandwich from all the ingredients you have 'bought'.

**Challenge level 3:** If you have worked out the answers to 1 and 2 above, can you work out how many full sandwiches you could make with the shopping you bought?

You could draw a table like this to help you. This is an example so you can get an idea:

Ingredient	Cost in total	Cost of what you need for one sandwich	Total cost
Loaf of bread	80p	2 slices - there are about 20 slices in a loaf of bread so 80p divided by 20 = 4p	4p
Butter	£2	Enough to cover two slices - bit of a guess here so use this price if you need it!	2p
Walkers salted crisps	84p	Half of the pack	42p
<b>Total cost of ingredients:</b>	<b>£3.64</b>	<b>Total cost of one sandwich:</b>	<b>50p</b>

Have fun doing this and we're sure you can out-imagine a crisp sandwich! Really looking forward to seeing your answers to this one!
