## Phonics :Read Write Inc.

We have put additional RWI materials in a new 'Channels' section. You can find 'Channels' next to where you find 'Files' and 'Assignments'.

These materials are optional and detail daily lessons that can be done over the next 2 weeks. As these lessons contain quite a few activities, we will change them fortnightly. This will allow you a couple of weeks to work through the different elements.

Have a look, they are quite detailed but remember these are optional. Maybe just focus on spelling the red and green words.



Draw a story map of the Hungry Caterpillar. Or why not draw a story map but change the caterpillar to another minibeast!




## Handwriting

Practice writing your letters. This week we are back to ladder letters. Really practise the **formation but also look at the size of the letter and where it sits on the line.**

The worksheets can be found in the files section. There are two this week.

If you can't print them out, just copy them onto some paper by hand. Write the letters in a yellow or orange pen or pencil for your child to trace over

You could also practise writing your first name. Again concentration on formation and sizing. Remember it starts with a capital letter too.



## Reading and writing Fact Files

Use the internet to gather information for a minibeast fact file.

Find out how many legs it has. How many wings? What does it eat, where does it live? Draw a picture of it.

There is a worksheet you can fill in on the assignment. You can also just make up your own fact file sheet or make it into a book.



## Listening
