- The Truth about Werewolves

You are now an expert on your chosen mythical creature.
Let's get planning your report, Professor!

Here are suggested headings. Try to brainstorm ideas for each one.

Think creatively and even include some surprising facts about your chosen creature!

What does a ...
look like?

Think about the words you will use to describe each body part! Will it be in a positive or negative way?

Where do ...
live?

Think about what type of climate/weather they might live in. Or what country? Is it on land or in the sea? In the sky?

What do ...
eat?

Is it nice food or disgusting food? Do they eat people? Are they famous for eating people but really they are vegetarians? (Like the Yetis in our story earlier this year!)

- Have I used adjectives to describe the mythical creature and build a picture of it? (Sprinkles - use a 'sentence of 3')
- Have I checked it all makes sense and I've used full stops/capital letters?
- Have I illustrated my report with pictures?
