Final Task – Design a Rollercoaster!

• You are going to design your own rollercoaster for Disneyland. For an extra challenge, try to build it out of junk materials or lego. Here is a checklist to help you...

To do	tick
Decide on a Disney theme, e.g, Frozen or the Incredibles.	
Think about ways you can make your model show your theme. You could decorate it, or have a character welcome customers onto the ride? Will you have themed music on the ride?	
Who will use your ride? You? An action figure or doll?	
Where are you going to build your ride? Inside with the furniture? Outside with what's in your garden? Junk model? Construction toys, e.g Lego or Skelectrix.	
What kind of ride is it going to be? Will it be a roller coaster or Big Wheel or a ride through attractions? Will there be water?	
How big or small will it be?	
Sketch out your plan in pencil so that you can rub out.	
Do a separate sketch for your car.	
Make a list of the materials you will need and do you have them?	
Alter your plan to suit what you have.	
Build your ride.	
Use your ride. Photograph it and post on Teams.
