<p>Task 1</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p>Numeracy</p> <p><u>Identify</u></p> <p>Choose a number card at random. Can you say the number on the flash card?</p> <p><u>Recognise</u></p> <p>Lay out 3 random number cards. The adult can call out one of the numbers and you point to it. Make it more challenging by adding more numbers.</p> <p>LI: I can identify and recognise numbers.</p>	<p>Task 2</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p>Reading</p> <p>Read a story together. Stop on a page you like and try to describe a character in the story. What words would you use? Brave, shy, friendly, mean, kind, tall, short?</p> <p>Try to describe their personality and what they look like.</p> <p>LI: I can describe a character.</p>
<p>Task 3</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p><u>Sounds</u></p> <p>Use your sound flashcards. Practise the actions and say the sound aloud.</p> <p>We know all of the sounds of the alphabet now.</p> <p>Other ideas:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Look up 'jolly phonics songs in order' on Youtube to listen and singalong to all of the jolly phonics songs we know.Use your flashcards to make three letter words e.g. cat <p>LI: I am learning to read.</p>	<p>Task 4</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p>Health and Wellbeing</p> <p>Winter is on the way! Practise doing up your zip or buttons yourself, putting on your gloves and fastening your shoes.</p> <p>Have a go at opening snack packets yourself too.</p> <p>LI: I am learning to be more independent.</p>
