<p>Task 1:</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p><b>Numeracy</b></p> <p><b>L.I. – I can recall number facts</b></p> <p>Login to Xtra Maths at home  <a href="https://xtramath.org/#/home/index">https://xtramath.org/#/home/index</a></p> <p>Use this link to enter the information from your Xtra Maths flyer which will give you access to your account.</p>	<p>Task 2:</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p><b>Writing</b></p> <p><b>L.I. – To build suspense</b></p> <p>Ask someone at home to find you an image of mysterious scene such as a derelict house, an abandoned railway or a spooky forest.  Describe the scene in one paragraph while building suspense for the reader.  Try using short, sharp sentences, adjectives, verbs and adjectives to create that feeling of unrest.</p>	<p>Task 3:</p> <p><input type="radio"/></p> <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p><b>L.I. – To use a dictionary</b></p> <p><b>Play Dictionary Dig.</b> Ask an adult to choose a word at random from the dictionary. They then give clues about the word and you have to use your dictionary to think what it could be. Clues should be broad initially which would allow for many possible words. You can record this by sending me the link or writing out the recipe again.
