Task 1 Mathematics



Pick from this range of data and analysis tasks:

Create a pictogram to show the colours of cars on your street.

Create a Venn diagram to show which numbers between 0 and 30 are in the 3 and 5 times tables.

Ask your family about their top three favourite fruit and create a bar chart to show the most popular choices.

Task 2 Reading

Task 3 Numeracy



See how many sums you can make up where these numbers are the answers:

10 12 25 48 64 100

e.g. $3 + 7 = 10$, $41 - 31 = 10$

Try to use +, -, x and ÷ if you can, or words like 'double' and 'half of'.

Task 4 Spelling



Using the common words and common misspellings lists found under "files", pick words you find challenging to spell and put them in lists:
