1.Read and Understand

Must: Draw a pictre of all the characters in the clip.

Should: Think of 3 words that would describe each character.

Could: Can you write a sentence for 2 of the characters using the adjectives (describing words)

e.g. Merida is a mischievous girl who is fun and curious.

2. Infer What's Not There

Must: Draw a picture of what you think will happen next in the movie <u>after</u> this clip stops?

Should: Write a sentence explaining what is happening.

Could: Create a 3-image story board showing what happens next. Add speech bubbles to your characters.

3. Explore Some More

- 1. Listen to the music in this clip. At the start you will hear some <u>celtic</u> music. Draw a picture of the instruments you can hear. Can you name them?
- 2. Listen to the music again. What emotions do you feel as you are listening to the music?

Must: Draw a picture showing the emotions you are feeling.

Should: Write a sentence using the emotion words to describe how the music makes you feel?

Could: describe how the music changes with your emotions. E.g. does it get louder, faster, softer?

4. Connect 4

Merida was learning how to use her new bow and arrow. She carried on learning her new skill even though it was really hard.

Think of a time when you were learning how to do something and you had to *persevere* in order to be able to do it.

Must: Draw a picture of the new skill you were learning.

Should: Write a sentence about the skill you were learning.

Could: In your sentence include how it made you feel.

Persevere: to keep going/ trying to do something even though it is hard.
