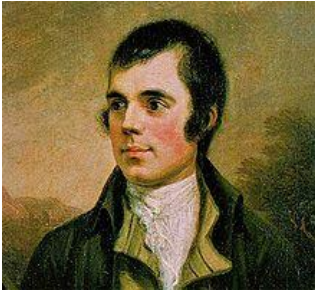
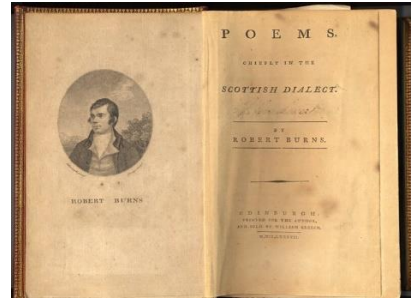


## Monday 25<sup>th</sup> January 21 - Robert Burns Day

mashed potatoes (tatties)



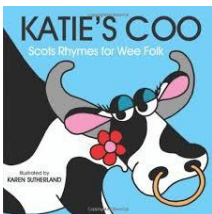
turnip (neeps)
