<p>Use the method of Look, Cover, Write and Check to make sure you've got it right! Here are some other spelling ideas for you to practice your words:</p> <p>-RAINBOW writing</p> <p>-SDRAWKCAB (backwards) writing</p> <p>-Silly sentences – write a silly sentence using your words</p> <p>-Create a Wordsearch</p> <p>-Hidden words – draw and colour a picture and hide your words inside it.</p> <p>-p py pyr pyra pyram pyrami pyramid writing</p> <p>- Bubble, squiggly, dot to dot, scrambled writing.</p> <p> Your spelling words will be sent in your resource pack on a two weekly basis.</p> <p>Remember to continue reading as much as possible at home!
