

LI: I am learning to continue a story in the style of the author. Plan and write an alternative ending to a story you have read. Alternatively, you can draw a picture to show the new ending.	LI: I am learning to create questions to show my understanding of characterisation. Imagine you are interviewing a character in your book. Write or discuss a list of questions that you would like to ask them. You could also think about what their responses could be. You may film your interview if you wish.	LI: I am demonstrating my understanding of a text I have read Choose the five most important events that happened in your book and turn them into a comic strip.	LI: I am learning to create a persuasive poster. Design a poster to advertise the book you are reading or a book that you have read. It should be persuasive to encourage people to read it.
