Literacy 	Can you draw a picture of yourself jumping in Autumn leaves? Think about adding detail to your face, body and clothes.	Draw a character from one of your favourite stories. Can you write or share one piece of information about this character.	Read for enjoyment every day for at least 10 minutes.
	Design a new front cover for one of your favourite stories. Can you create a story map with an adult which tells a story about kindness? You can use a story you already know or you can make one up.
Numeracy and Maths 	Practise numeracy skills using games on the Top Marks website. Focus on counting games www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/5-7-years/counting And ordering/sequencing https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/5-7-years/ordering-and-sequencing	Practise saying the Days of the Week to an adult. Can you challenge yourself even further by practising the months of the year?	This month is September. Can you think of 2 facts that make September special?
	Practise counting forwards and backwards within 20. Ask an adult to give you the starting number.	Choose a recipe with an adult and have a go at making something delicious. Make sure you have all the ingredients and equipment before you start.	List 3 2D shapes. Ask an adult to help you create a tally chart using these shapes and record how many of each shape you can find in your house or garden.
HWB/Global Citizenship 	Draw a picture of someone who helps us in our community. This could be someone like a police officer, fire fighter or doctor.	Create an exercise circuit or obstacle course in your garden. Try using everyday items to add extra challenge such as balls, skipping ropes and even garden furniture. Complete against family members to see who can do it in the fastest time.
