Literacy	Look in your reading book or another book you are enjoying at home. Try to find a tricky word or a word that you don't know. Write down what you think it means. Now check it in a dictionary (you can ask an adult to help you use an online dictionary if you don't have one at home). Were you correct? How close did you get to the meaning?	Choose a character from a book you are reading and draw them into their own comic strip! It could be funny, exciting or scary – you can choose what happens! Remember to give the story a beginning, middle and end.	Read for enjoyment every day for at least 20 minutes. Try to read a range of texts and genres.
	Write a letter to your future self about your experiences during your time away from school. Think about the important things you have learned, what you've missed most and what you're most looking forward to!	Use the websites below to practice spelling a range of common words. You could practise performing as the different characters and try to memorise the lines your character says in the scene. Think about how your character would move, speak and act. Use expression in your voice to bring them to life!
Numeracy and Maths	Practise numeracy skills using games on the Top Marks website https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/5-7-years/addition-and-subtraction Try to focus on quick recall of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts.	Measure: With the help of an adult, use some kitchen scales to measure the weight of 5 household items. Write down the weight of each. Now choose 5 other household items and use your previous measurements to help you to estimate (a clever guess!) how much each one will weigh. See how close you can get to the correct weight!	Number detective! Be a detective and think creatively. Follow the clues and use your reasoning skills to find the mystery number.
