Task 1



Numeracy: Doubles

L.I. To speedily recall double facts up to 20

Start with doubles to 5 can you quickly recall all your double facts? (1 + 1, 2 + 2, 3 + 3, 4 + 4, 5 + 5)

When you are super speedy at saying all of these facts in a random order move on to doubles up to 10. (6 + 6, 7 + 7, 8 + 8, 9 + 9, 10 + 10)

Practise your double facts by playing [Hit the button Doubles](https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button) and select Doubles to 10.

Extra challenge

When you are confident with your doubles to 10. See if you can use your double facts to answer some near doubles. e.g

7 + 6 = (I know 7 and 7 is 14 so 7 + 6 is one less so it is 13)

Try – 9 + 8, 8 + 7, 6 + 5 etc
