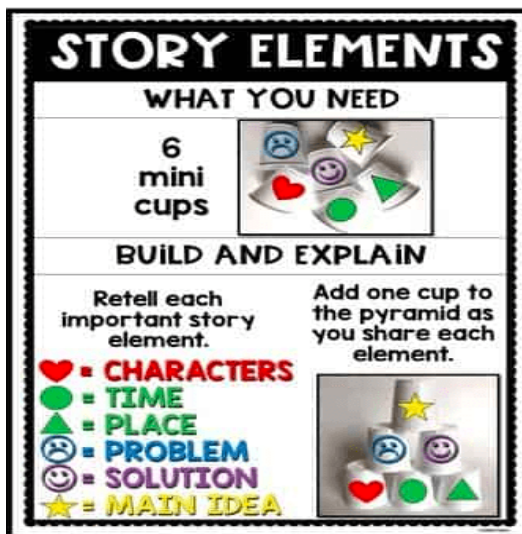




Early Level Remote Learning Grid January 2022
