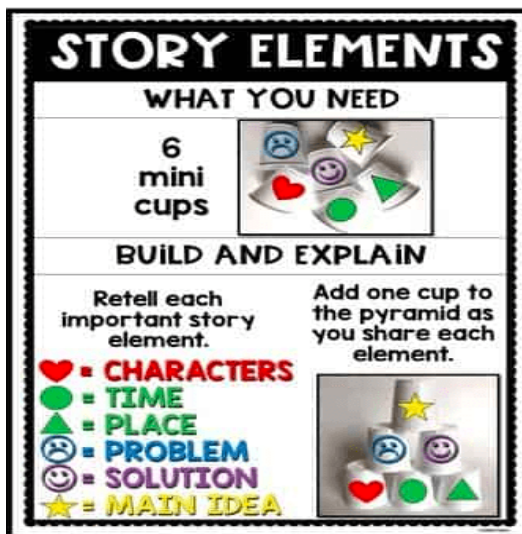




First Level Remote Learning Grid January 2022
