Head Teacher Update

It has been wonderful to welcome so many families to school for Sports Days, Shared Learning and volunteers for trips.

Our new tunnel, maze and climbing frame are almost ready for use. The children will get an opportunity to explore the equipment and learn the rules for safe use before including it in our playground rota.

We have been playing music on a Tuesday and Wednesday lunchtime from 12:30-13:15 in the playground in response to requests from pupils as it encourages some children who otherwise find playtimes difficult or long to share a common interest. The feedback from the children is that this makes them feel happy and it encourages them to exercise. We have limited it to two lunchtimes .

We bought some fantastic resources with £750 from the money raised from the Danceathon to start our STEM area in the Blue (P1-4) atrium.

We are conscious that families may be experiencing cost of living difficulties. Please speak to the school office or member of SLT if we can support you to be included in school opportunities.





Classes for next year



We will have three Primary 1 classes this year.

The three current Primary 1 classes will become two Primary 2 classes.

There will be two Primary 3 classes, a Primary 4/3 and two Primary 4 classes.

We have taken the opportunity to mix the current three Primary 4 classes into three new Primary 5 classes so that children can form relationships across the year group as they will benefit from extended friendship groups when they go to high school and mix with children from five other primary schools. We have ensured that we have taken friendship groups and distributed ages across the year. Other factors such as gender and Additional Support Needs are also taken into consideration.

We will have three Primary 6 classes and three Primary 7 classes.

Children going into P2 and P5 will get a note of their new class week beginning 12 June so that they can experience this on 16 June when we have our induction taster for next session. Where teachers have been identified they will also meet their teacher but it may not be possible for this to be in place for that day due to the decisions on staffing still to be made at Local Authority level.



Nursery children do not need to bring anything.




Primary Seven

We would appreciate your support to donate good quality, pre-loved items. Please see the list on the next page.


Play is not a break from learning.

Thank you and to the groups of children from Primary 4 and Primary 7, who were amazing in their leadership roles, supporting the administration of each others days!


A final thank you to all of the staff who worked hard behind the scenes, and on the days of each event to enable our Sports afternoons to run as smoothly as possible.
