Literacy

Reading

We will be looking at the meaning of words, fluency and summarising.

Writing

Our writing will be a mixture of personal and functional writing.

Listening and Talking

This will be linked to Health and Wellbeing. The children will take part in class discussions linked to a variety of topics. Our focus for these discussions will be the Health and Wellbeing Indicators.

Numeracy and Maths

In numeracy the children will be learning about addition and subtraction of numbers with more than 3 digits, percentages and decimals and the multiplication of 2 \times 2/3 digit numbers. We will also work on strategies related to problem solving.

In our maths lessons the children will be covering budgeting during lessons related to money and looking at the properties of shapes and how to calculate the area of different shapes.

At home children could work on money and what they could buy with an amount, times tables and the associated division facts and the quick recall of addition and subtraction facts within 10/100/1000. I will also give out some consolidation/revision sheets to help with the end of year test for the High School.

Health and Wellbeing

In class the children have the opportunity to talk about things through Bubble Time. This will continue next term. We will continue to look at the Health and Wellbeing Indicators and be working on a programme linked to Resilience.

Your Space continues to be a service in school which the children can access should they want to talk to another person about things they are finding difficult. The children self refer themselves at break or lunch time. The Health and Wellbeing of your child is extremely important to me.
