


# All about your school

Do not put your coat on the floor. If you see a coat on the floor please pick it up.



# <u>Uniform</u>

# <u>School bag</u>

Please bring a school bag to school every day to put your reading book and homework in.



#### Trays

You have a tray with your name on it. Put your snack and books in your tray. You can leave your pencil case in your tray.

#### <u>Milk</u>

#### Water Bottle

Please bring your own water bottle to school with you. Ask someone at home to put your name on it. Please do not bring a glass bottle or cans to school. <u>No</u> energy drinks are allowed

# School Dinners

There is a big choice of healthy food for lunch, but do not worry, there are lots of people to help you in the dinner hall.

All children in P1-P5 are eligible for a free school meal.

Please inform the school office if your child has any food allergies



# Packed Lunch

You can bring a packed lunch to school.

Please beware we are a nut free school, this includes Nutella chocolate spread in sandwiches.

You eat it in the dinner hall.

There is water to drink or you can bring your own juice - but not a fizzy or energy drink!

Please do not bring a glass bottle or cans to school.



#### <u>Parent Pay</u>

All payments are made through Parent Pay, once your child has started you will be issued with login details on how to Pay for items, ie milk or trips, please signup as all items and trips, throughout their time in school are paid through Parent Pay

#### <u>Play time</u>

You will play in the Primary 1 playground at break and dinnertime.



A supervisor will look after you and your Buddy from P7 will be there to play with you.

In the playground, you must not hit, kick, push or fight. If somebody does this please tell the playground supervisor.

If you are upset about anything please tell your teacher.

When it is a wet day you go into the atrium where Learning Assistants will look after you at break and dinnertime.


Please put your name in <u>both</u> of your wellies and bring a pair of gym rubbers or a pair of shoes to change into.
