Dear Parent / Carer

September has been such a quick month!! Our staff and children have all settled back into life in school whilst still staying as COVID safe as possible. Data forms are not only used to obtain the email address for the main contact for each child but also to confirm that the contact details we hold for you are up to date. The forms were issued alongside blue trip permission forms and photo permission forms and every child in school was issued with a set of forms. I cannot stress how important it is that you return these immediately when they are issued. If you have received a chaser via text message, please return the forms straight away or if you have lost or misplaced them, please email or call our school office for replacements.
