The School Improvement Plan sets out our priorities for the year ahead. We aim to ensure all learners receive the best possible education and that our school continues to grow and develop. It has been written after gathering feedback from our school community. As always, we appreciate your contributions and feedback.

Some of our highlights from last session 2020-2021

- We worked with Covid-19 restrictions to ensure that children were happy and safe. This included staggered starts, finishes and breaks, changes to class cover arrangements and how we organised Support for Learning. We held virtual 'Meet the Teacher' in September and new P1 sessions in June.
- Following our school building closure from January-March we engaged with children and families through the use of Google Classroom, including Google Meets and virtual assemblies.
- We supported Keyworker families with the delivery of Emergency Childcare in school during our period of remote learning.
- We supported vulnerable children during school closure with school spaces, digital devises and learning resources
- Opportunities for staff to evaluate practice and progress against 'How Good is our School' indicators have given staff opportunities to be reflective practitioners, discuss good practice and develop next steps, resulting in quality experiences for their classes
- Permanent Head Teacher appointed
