


# Mayfield Nursery School

Dear Parent/Carer

Many thanks for helping the Mayfield Nursery Community prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. It is a very infectious virus and it takes all of us to be really careful and stick to the public health measures in place to keep everyone in the community safe.

The NHS Director of Public Health and Health Policy has asked us to give you all a letter from them with information about how we can all help try to keep schools and nurseries open, safe and COVID free.

I know you will all want to help us.

One important message is that if your child has any of the following symptoms:

- a new persistent cough and/or
- a high temperature and/or
- a loss or change in taste or smell

PLEASE don't send them to nursery. In this case follow NHS advice and ensure everyone in your household stays at home. Then organise for your child to have a COVID test. You can do this by visiting NHS inform or by phoning 0800 028 2816.

If your child has symptoms and the test comes back as negative they can return to nursery once they have had no symptoms for 48 hours and are feeling better.

Please show us the negative test result. This helps us monitor cases and keeps the nursery community safe and reassured.

Many thanks for your support and understanding, we have never known a virus like this and so this is new for everyone. We will support each other and follow the guidance to try to stay open, safe and COVID free.
