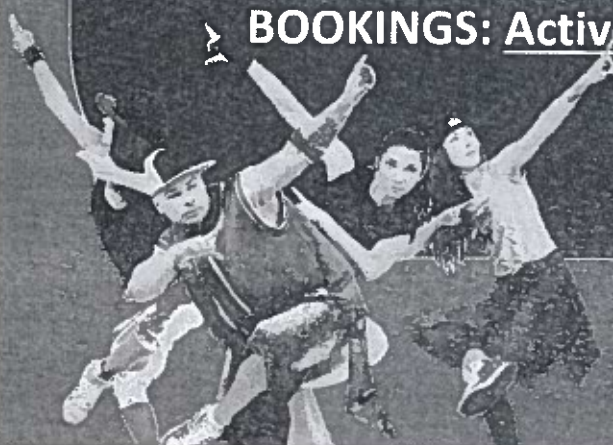

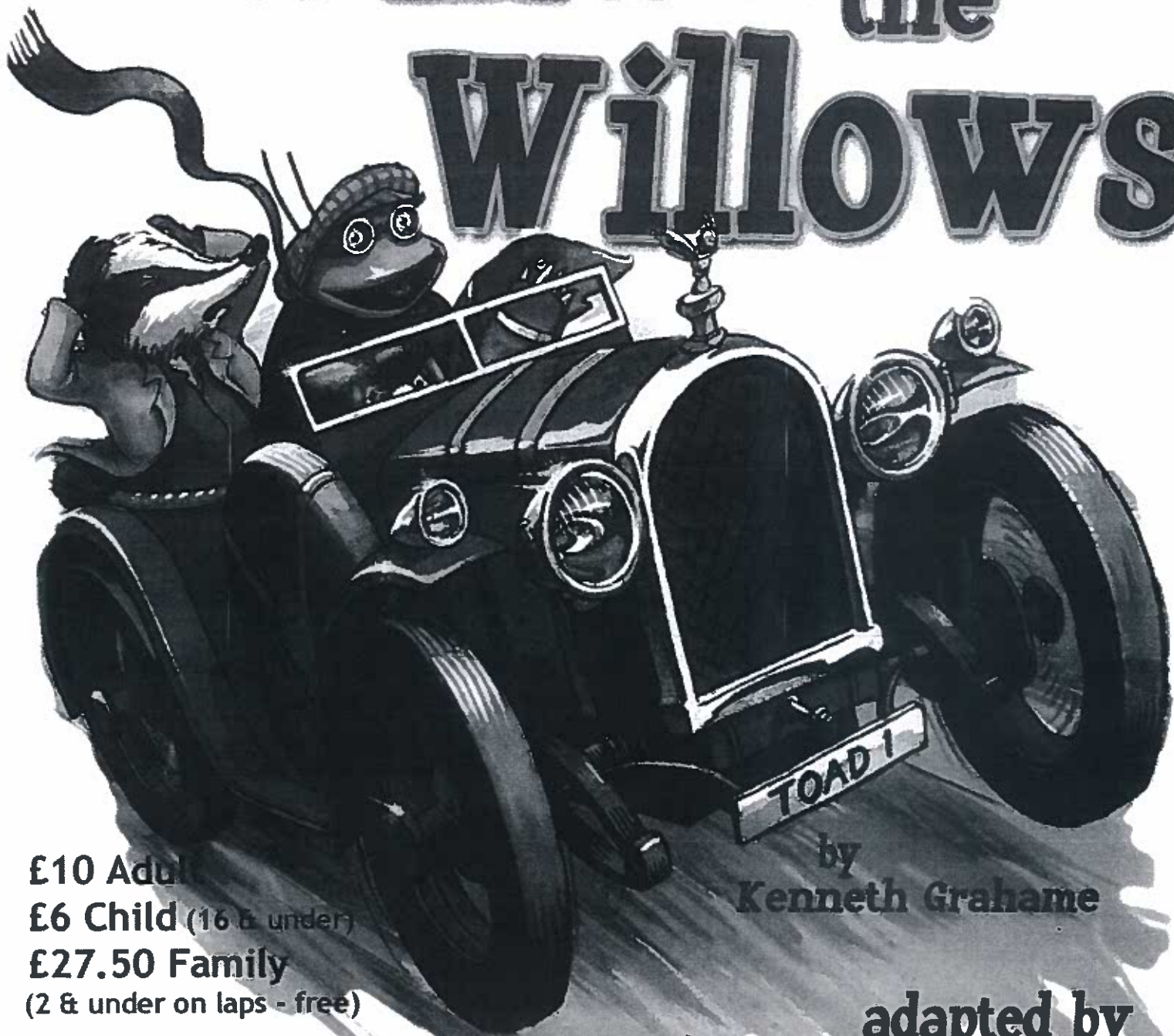

## Low cost no cost activities Summer

- Make a "den" by pegging sheets to chairs. Inside or outside old sheets /blankets
- Take a picnic to the park, or have a "carpet" picnic in the house.
- Bake cakes or tray bakes together.
- Make a pizza.
- Play "make believe" - schools, shops, tea parties.
- Wheels day - bike/ scooter / skates outing.
- Plant some seeds in old shoes / wellies for the garden.
- Walk in woods and gather items for collage
- Make a collage - use gathered items, pasta, cut out pictures.
- Play "I Spy".
- Make up dance sequence and put on a show
- Read a story, or make up your own.
- Make "mud pies" in the garden -old clothes, pots, empty containers / spoons
- Make pasta pictures - school glue /paper /different pasta shapes / paint
- Play "Hide and Seek".
- Blow bubbles and try to catch them.
- Play "Simon Says" follow your child's lead.
- Play statues with music
- Dressing up time (old clothes including adults clothes/ sheets etc)
- Jigsaw puzzles / board games
- Handprint paintings - trees / suns etc
- Sand or flour tray drawings (outside if messy)
- Paper plate or old socks puppet making - string and buttons/ stickers for eyes.
- Make cardboard box theatre for puppets
- Teach old games e.g skipping / hopscotch / kirby (where safe)
- Make skittles with old plastic bottles - fill with 1/3 water for stability
- Make kitchen roll tube open bracelets and decorate
- Rainbow nature walk using colour spotting e.g. green grass, blue sky etc
- Tray memory game 10 or 20 items on tray, study for 2 mins then cover & remember
- Ball games in the park...football, dodgeball, piggy in the middle etc.
- Shopping...with child list /pictures of foods to look out for in the store.
- Pass the parcels with a bag of dressing up clothes.
- Make friendship bracelets with old threads or wool or hair braids
- Make button pictures with buttons, bottle tops etc
- Egg Carton building e.g.
- Make rubbings - thin paper/crayons on tree bark, leaves, pavements, stones.
- Sock Paper weights -fill with sand or dried pulses and tie at neck/bottom.
- Pasta necklaces - wool and pasta tubes / painted.
- Play targets - rolled up socks into empty bin or bucket, tray, bucket
- Plastic cup weaving - cut cup downwards (odd number eg 7 or 9 cuts) from rim leaving 0-5 cm at bottom uncut - weave wool out and in the cuts forming patterns.
