P7 also suggested lots of various rewards and how much they should cost. They can choose to spend or save the money they earn to buy a reward of their choosing.

Also, I will be encouraging lots of positive behaviour by sending postcards and certificates home. So please be on the look out for these and continue this praise at home.

### PE and Health and Wellbeing

P7 will have PE on Tuesdays with myself and Wednesdays with Mr Cook, our PE specialist. PE kits can be kept in school. I would appreciate if pupils could bring an appropriate PE kit to school in order to fully participate in the lessons. It is also good preparation for when they move onto secondary school next year.
