We will work extremely hard to raise attainment levels in numeracy and literacy. We will build on the children's prior knowledge and then move forward.




Topics will be based around Our Planet.

- Animals and their habitats
- Climates and map reading skills connected to habitats

In addition we will learnt about Festivals around the world (which continue all year) and carry out a book study on one of Roald Dahl's books (class will choose)

In **Numeracy** we will be focusing on the 5 domains every week which include number sequences and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, equations and algebra, fractions, percentages and decimals.



In **Maths** we will be learning about time, analogue and digital and money. Please practise this at home as often as you can!
In **Literacy** we will continue with a skills based approach to reading and comprehension.

We will also be following a Resilience Recovery programme and a **Health and Wellbeing** programme.
