The Term Ahead

Topic/IDL

This term we will be finishing our dinosaur topic which the children are really enjoying. We will also be doing some learning about Christmas and how it is celebrated around the worlds

We are also reading the BFG in class which everyone is really enjoying so we will be doing some learning linked to the story such as wow words, friendship, bullying and creative writing.

Literacy

Read, Write, Inc is now set up and running smoothly in the class and the children will continue working on their reading and writing skill through small group sessions with an adult, games which focus on sounds and blending and a mixture of writing and handwriting activities and worksheets.

Numeracy and Maths

In numeracy we will be focusing on strategies to help us with numbers, number bonds to 10 and 20, halving and doubles, and using a number line for both subtraction and addition. Throughout the week, we will cover number structures, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions. They will learn through whiteboard activities, table top games, written tasks and smart board games.

In Maths we will be focusing on reading the time on an analogue and digital clock and shape.
