



Steps for Accessing Seesaw – here is a series of screenshots and hopefully this will help

Google Seesaw

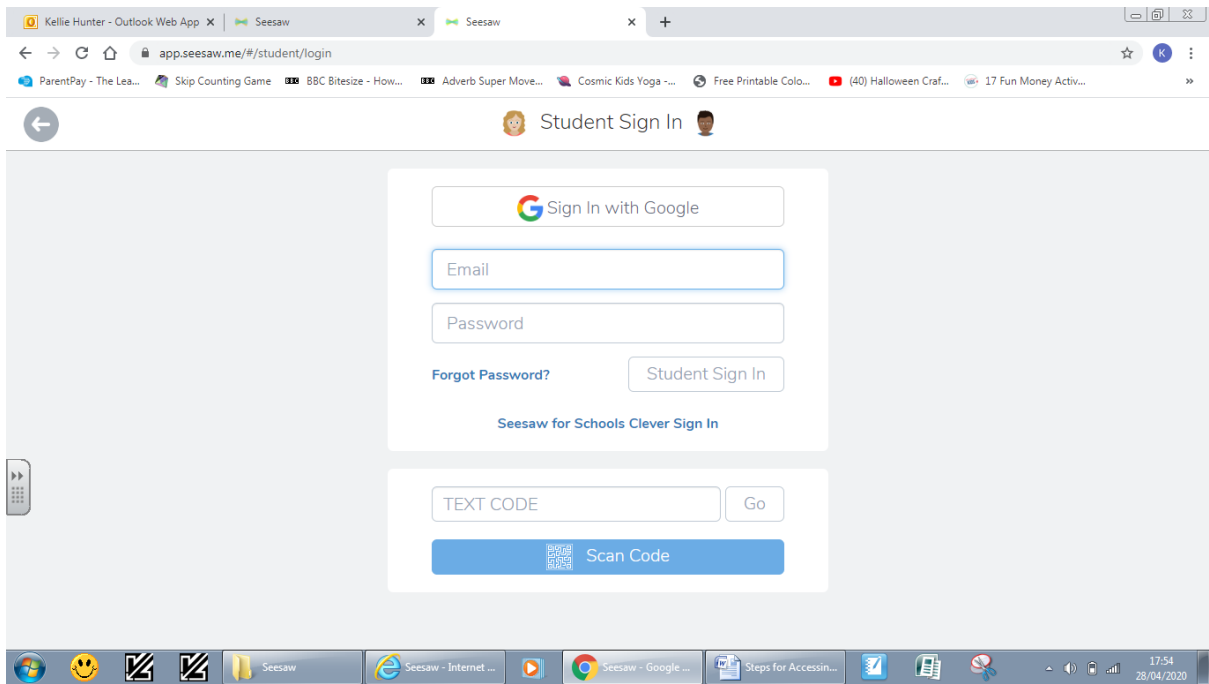

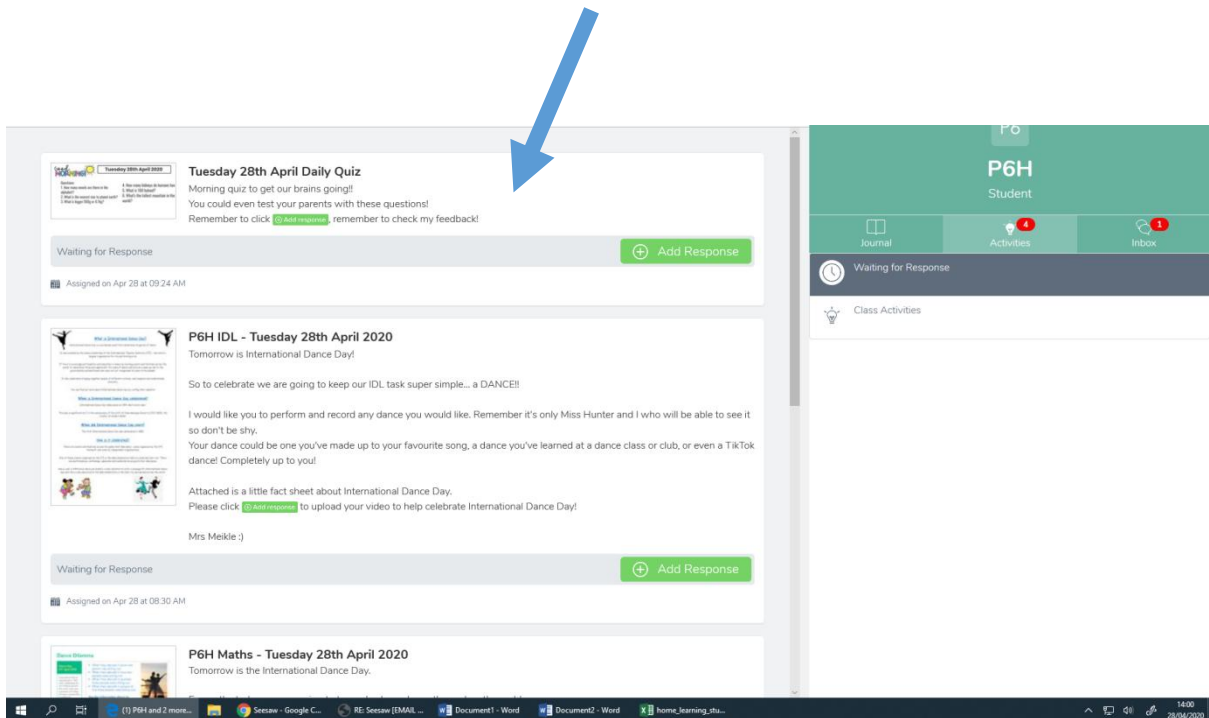


Type in the text code if it is on a computer. Press scan code if on a tablet or phone.

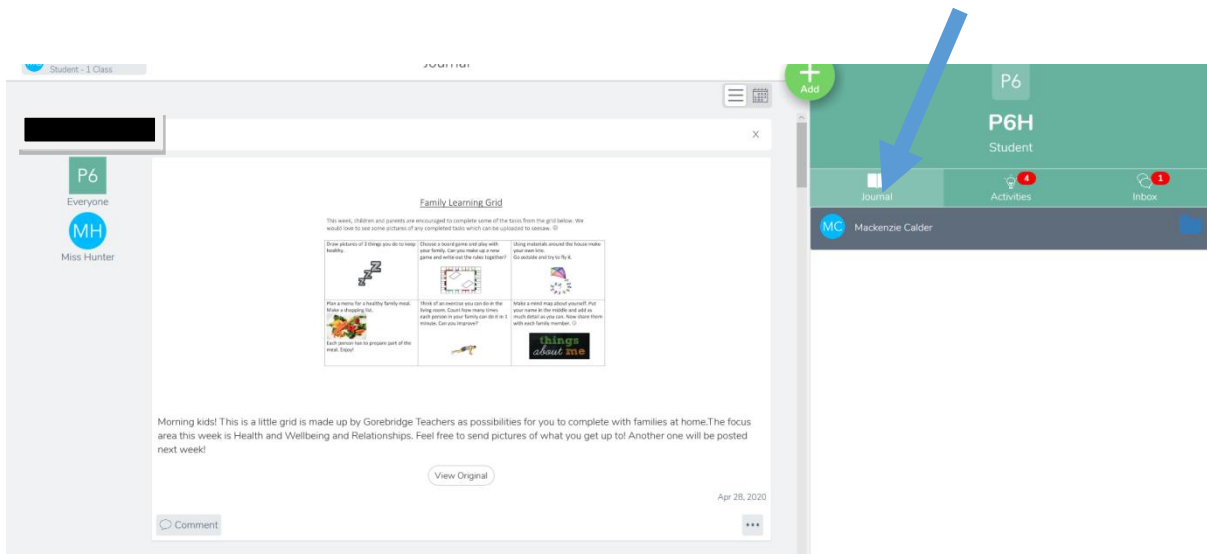
Hit go!

Then your child's page will appear. This page will vary depending on what your Teacher has posted.

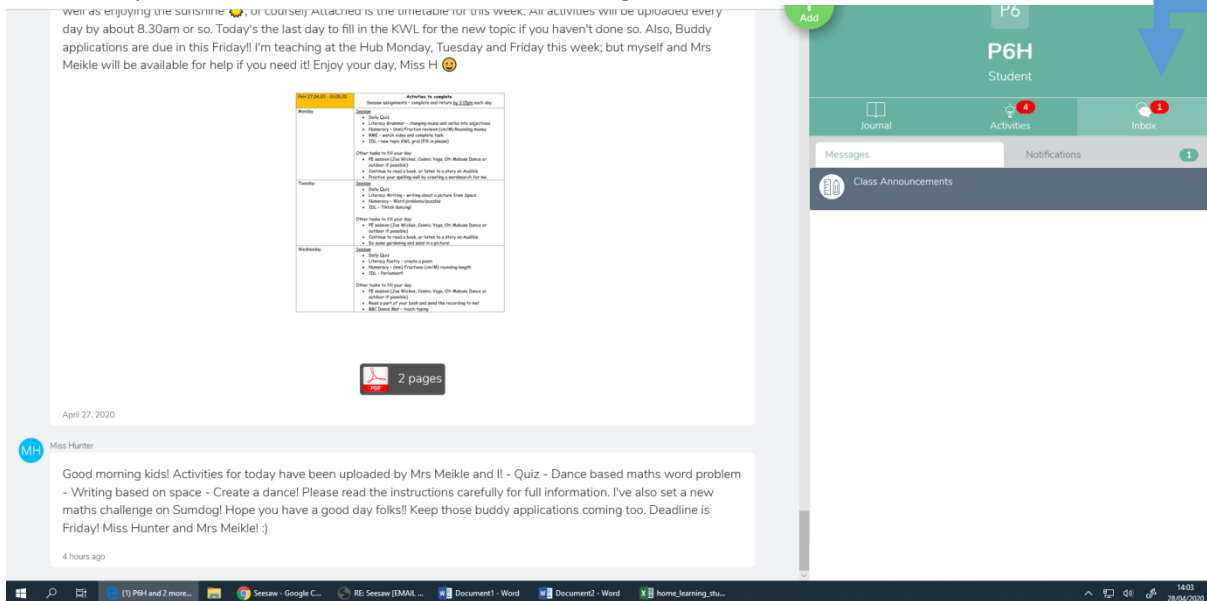
This arrow is pointing to the activities for the day



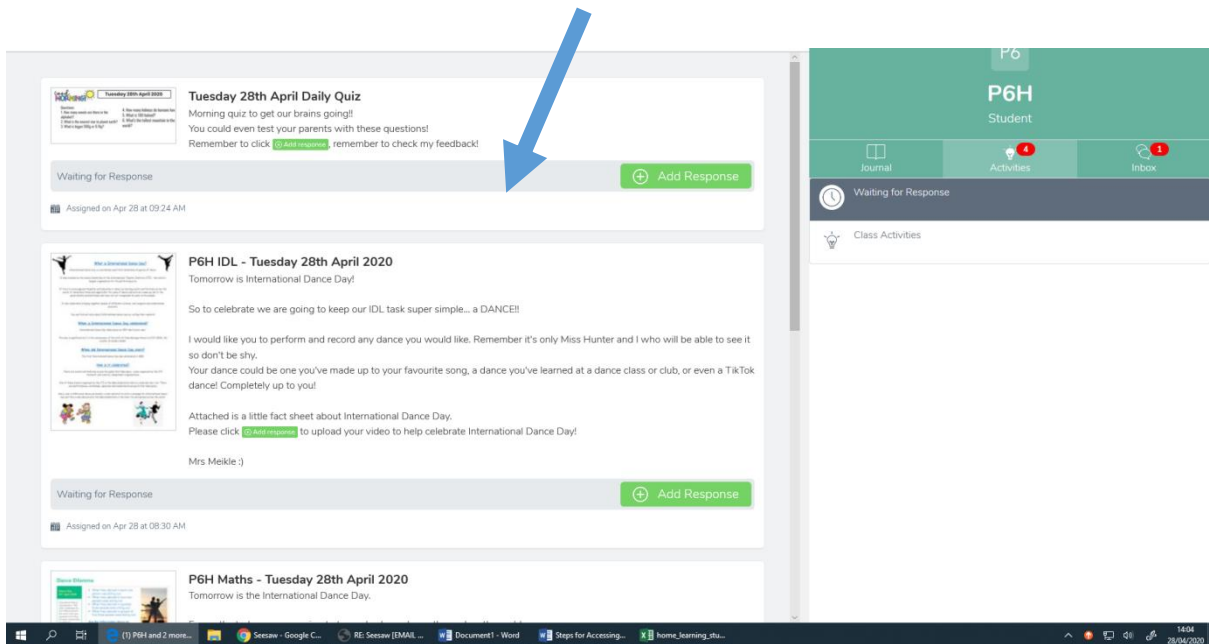
This arrow points to his journal. This shows all of your child's work and also any notifications or messages that have been directly sent.



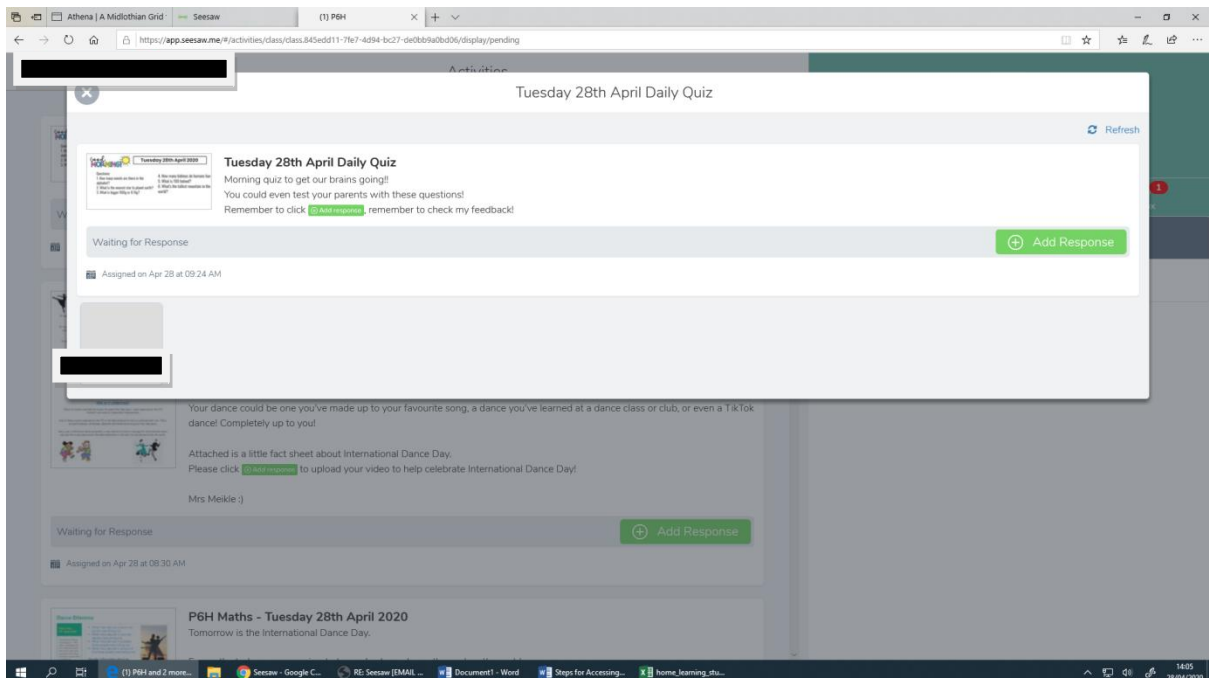
This arrow points to the inbox. This shows all messages me sent to the class.



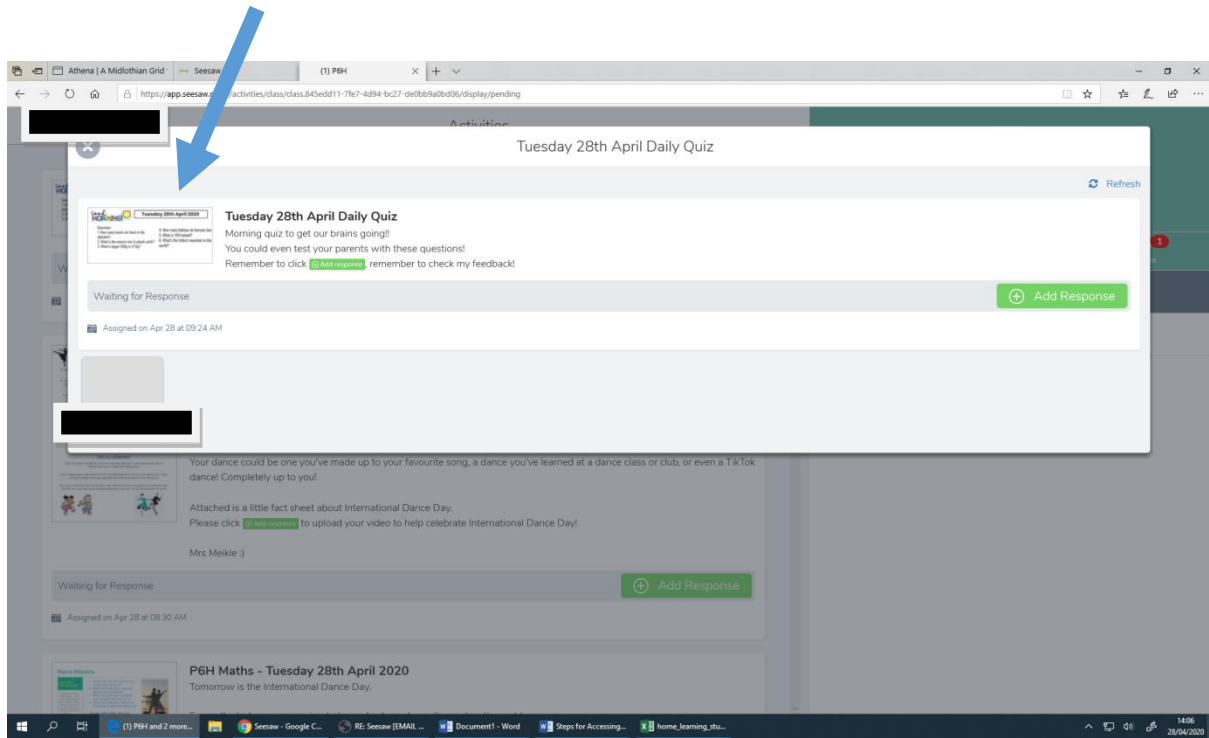
Let's go back to activities and then click on the actual activity (e.g. Daily Quiz). Any activities you need to do will appear here.



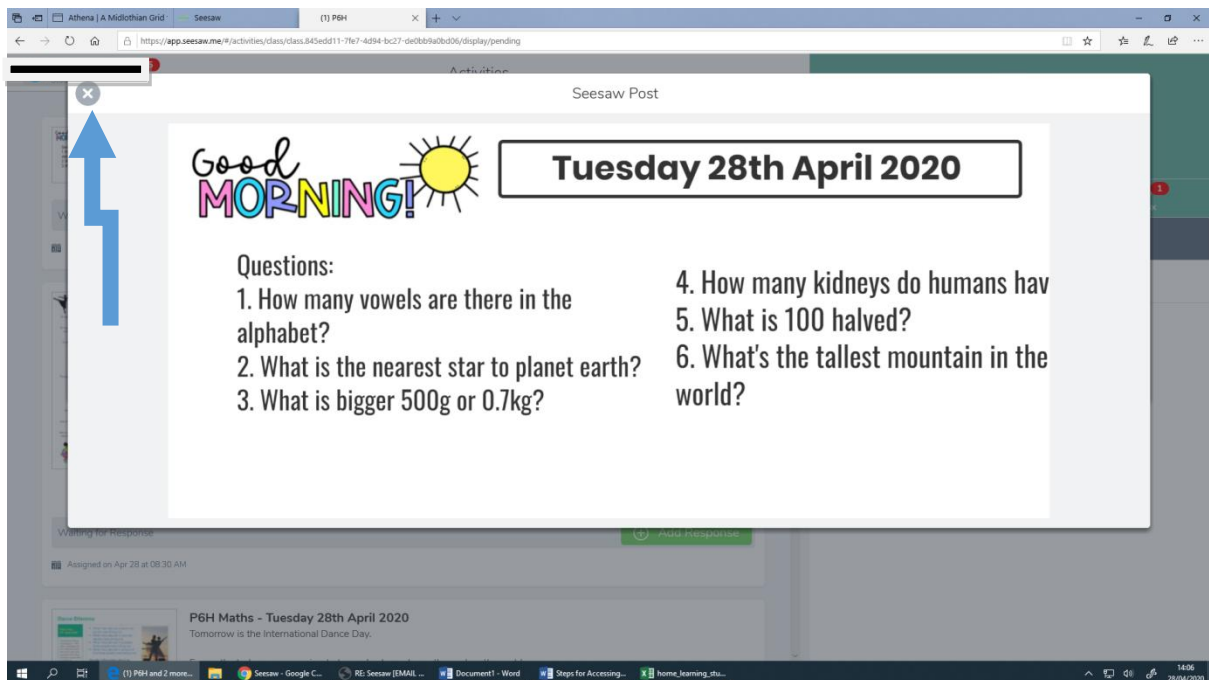
Clicking on this, a bigger version will appear. This explains the task.



Click here to view a bigger version of the task

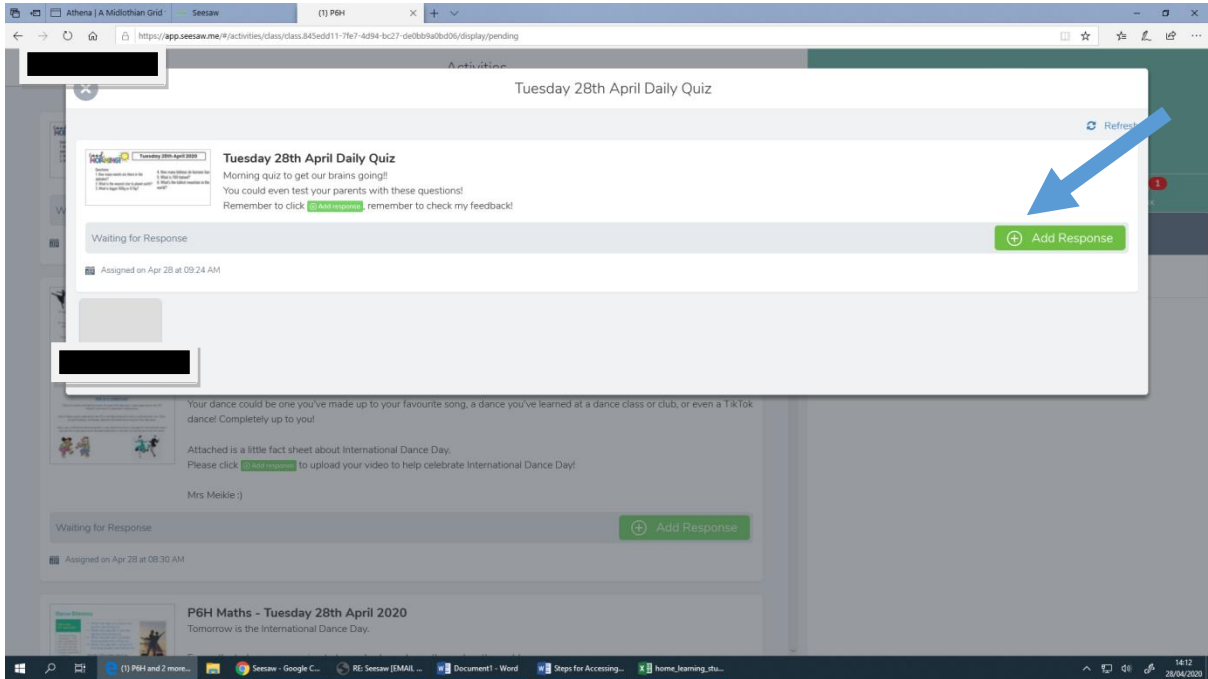


A bigger version for tasks will appear here.

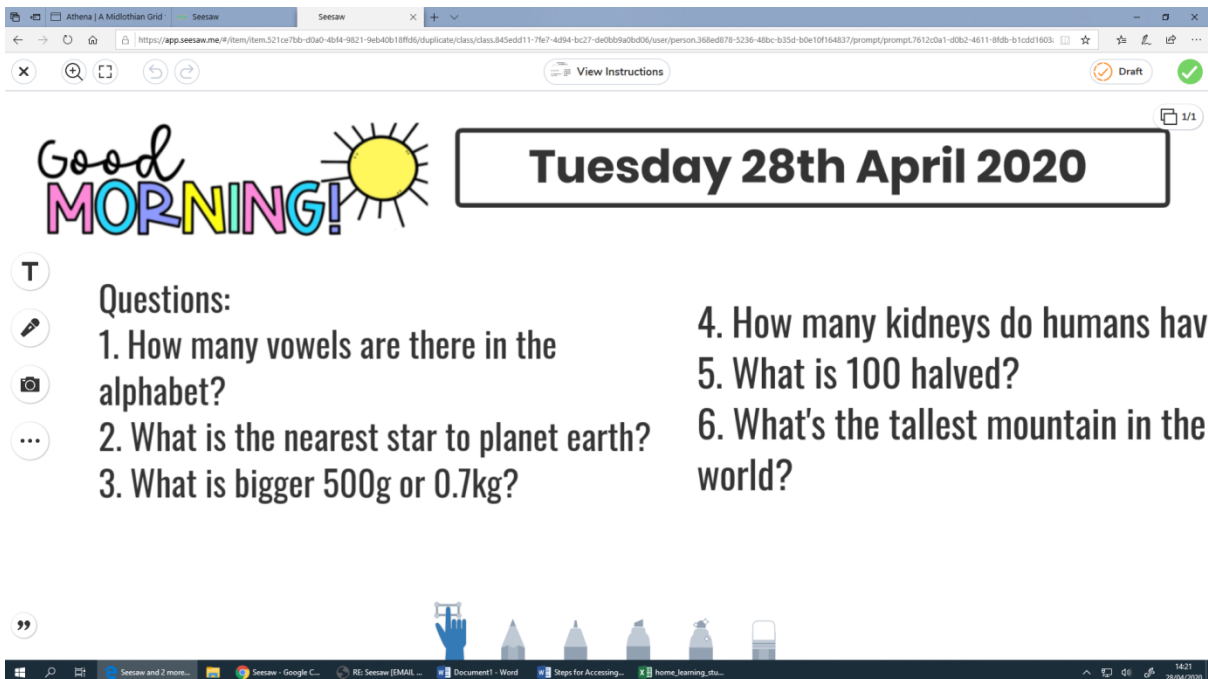


Click the x to exit.

The activity page(s) will come up!





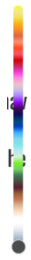
Press this to add a text box

Drag the button on this 'rainbow' to change the colour of text or pen colour.

Put in answers and then press green tick. This will assign the work to the teacher. When the teacher has given feedback it will appear in the child's journal!

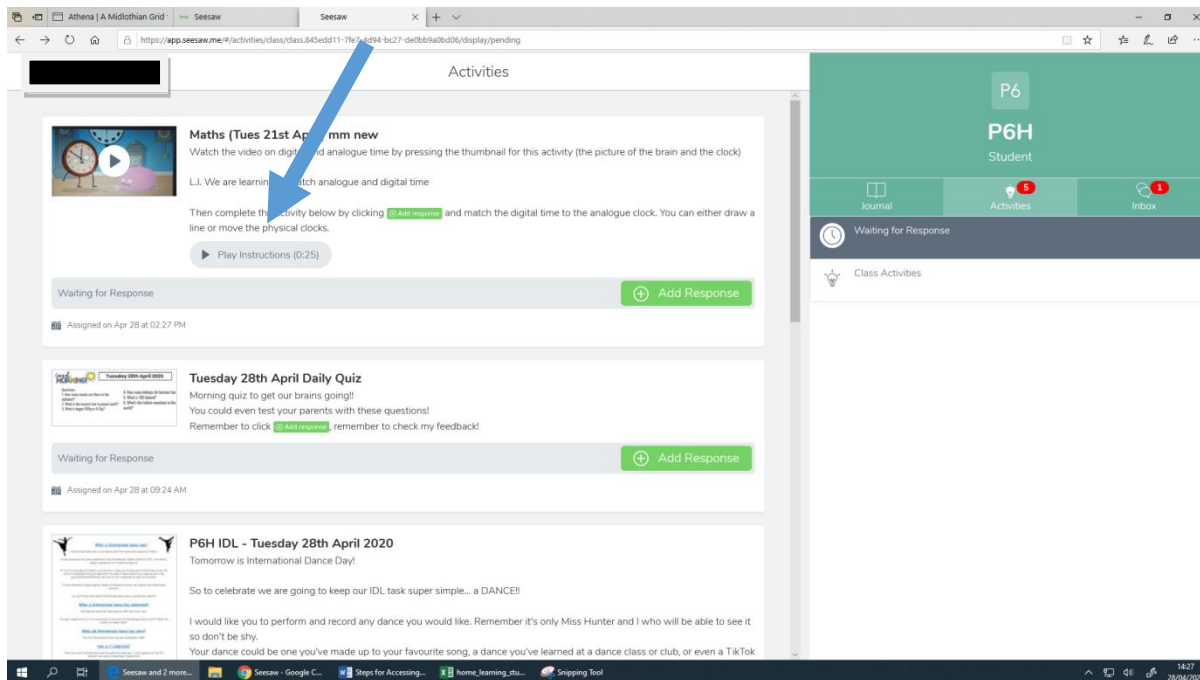

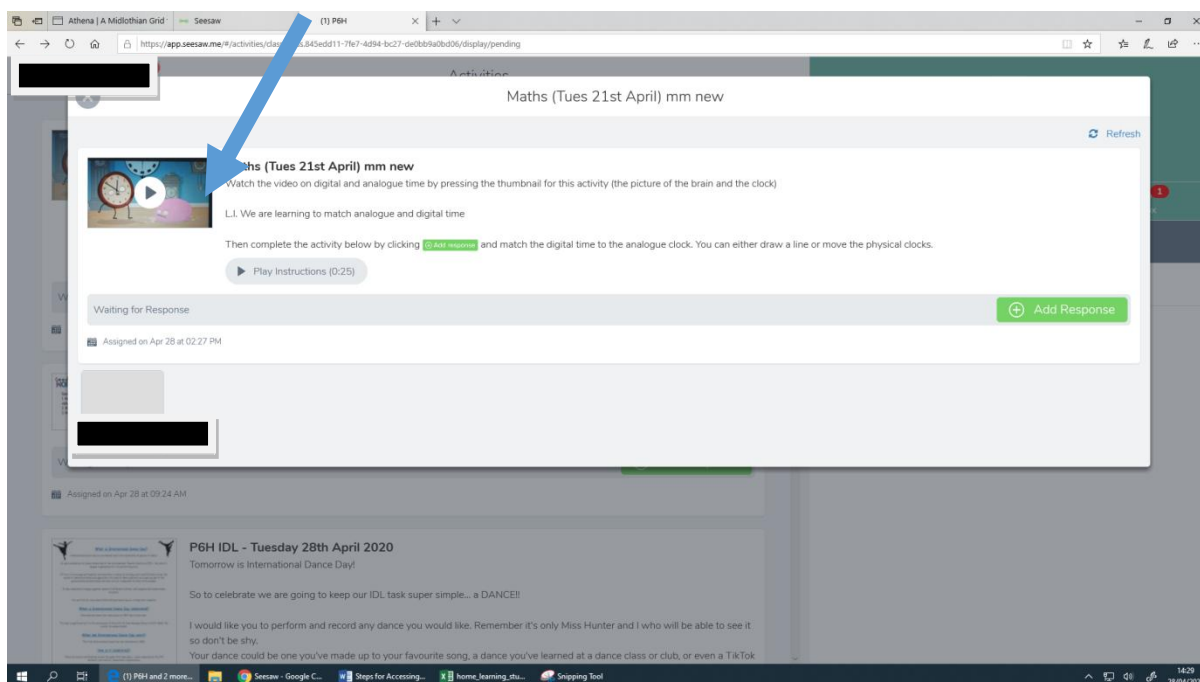
- How many vowels are there in the alphabet? Answer 1

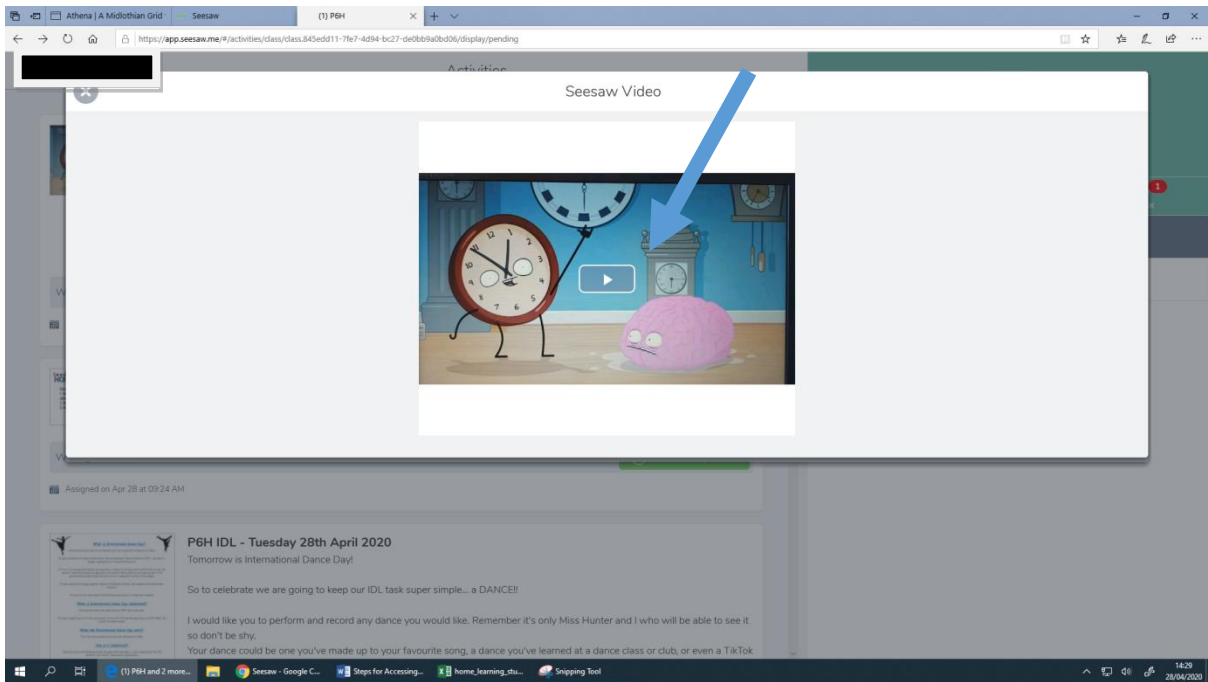


If there is a video uploaded then press here to view the video.

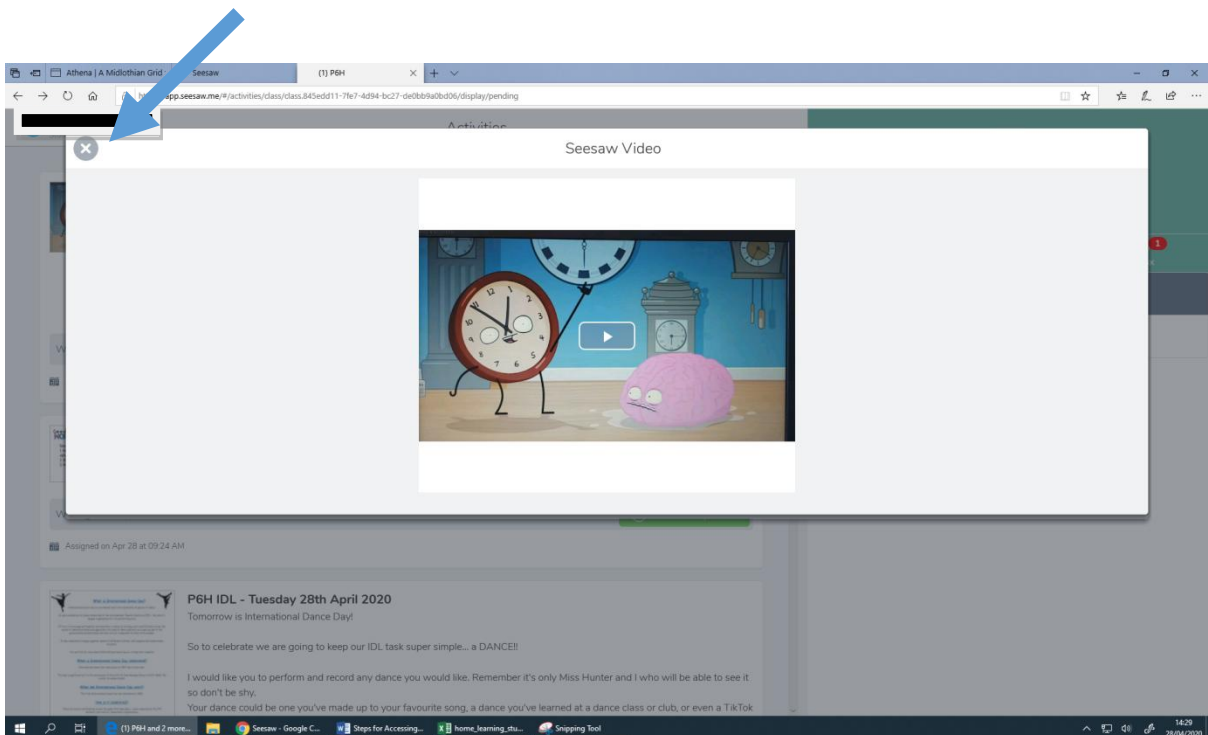


After pressing play, this will show you the video. It might be your teacher talking, but sometimes there are external links to Youtube or a website to explore.

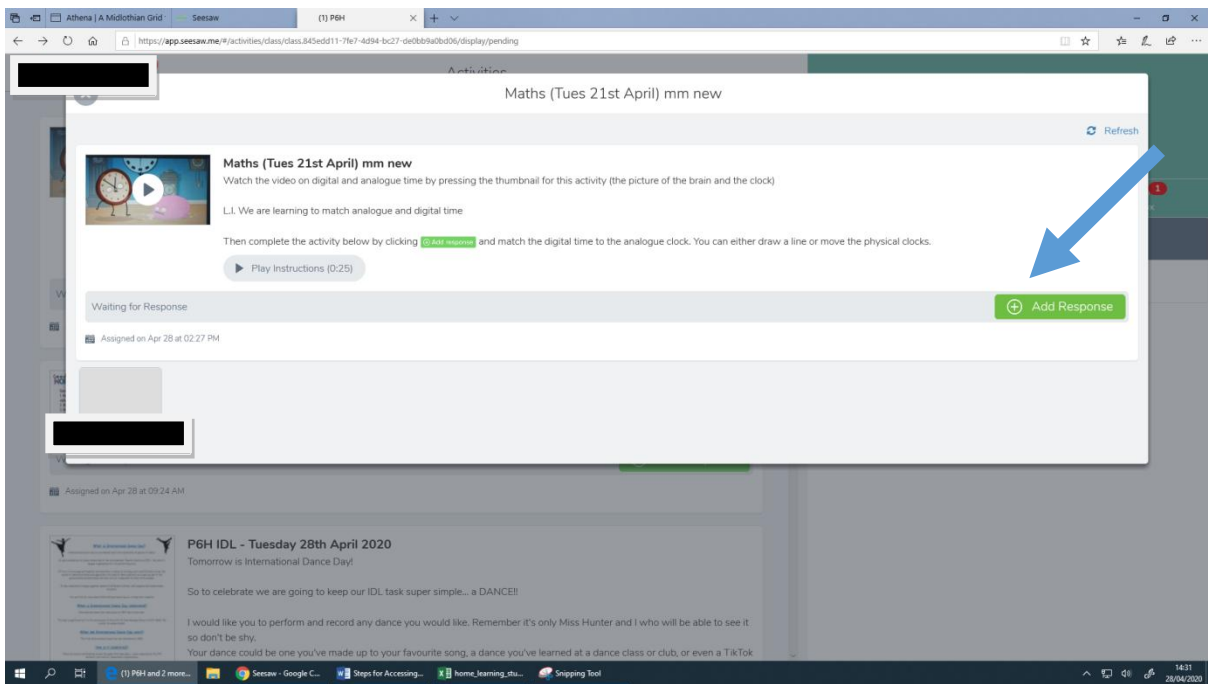
Press here to get access to the video or external link.



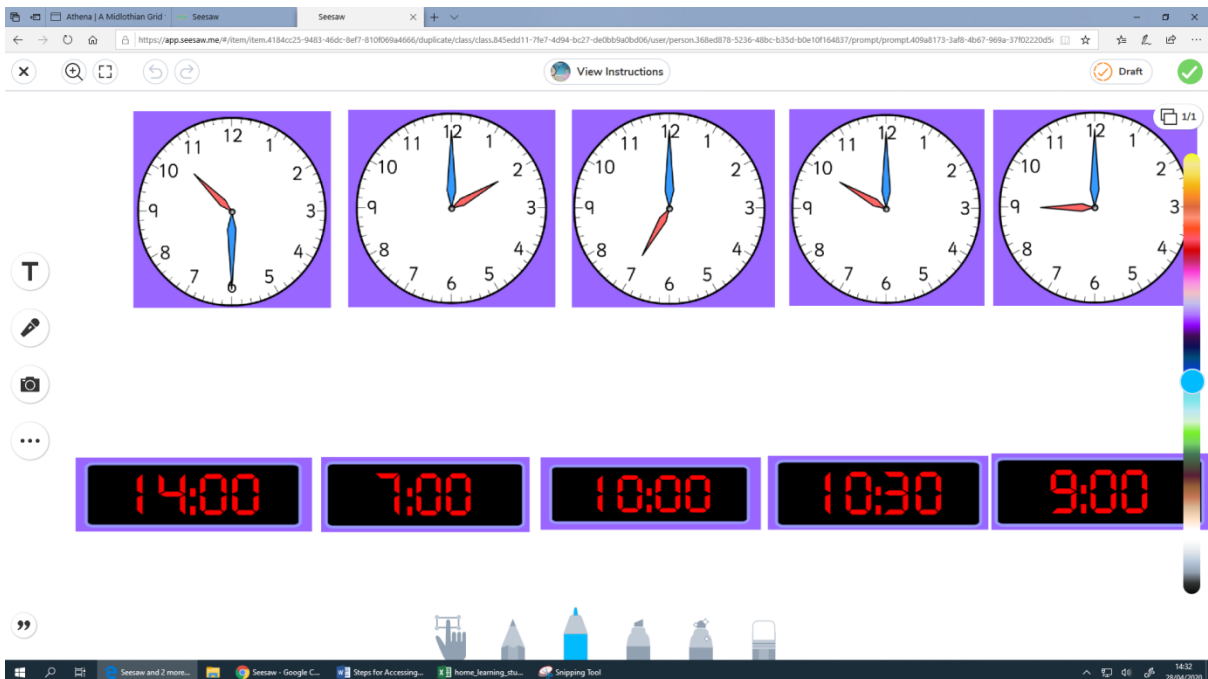
After watching, press the x



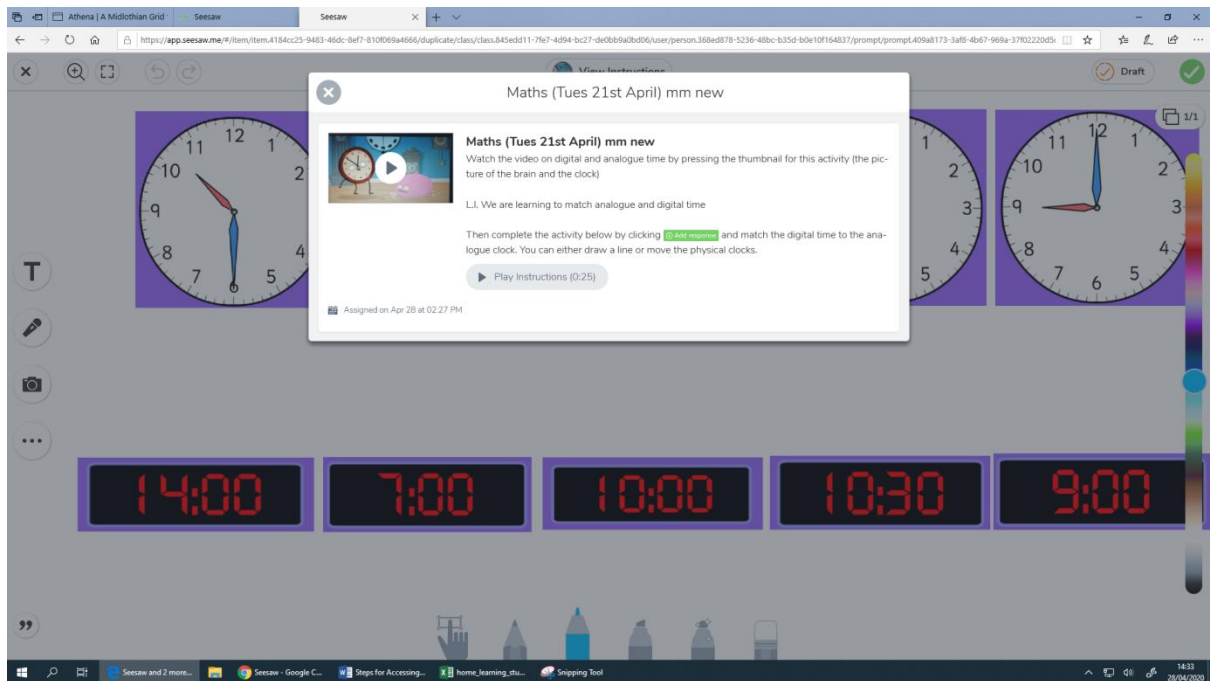
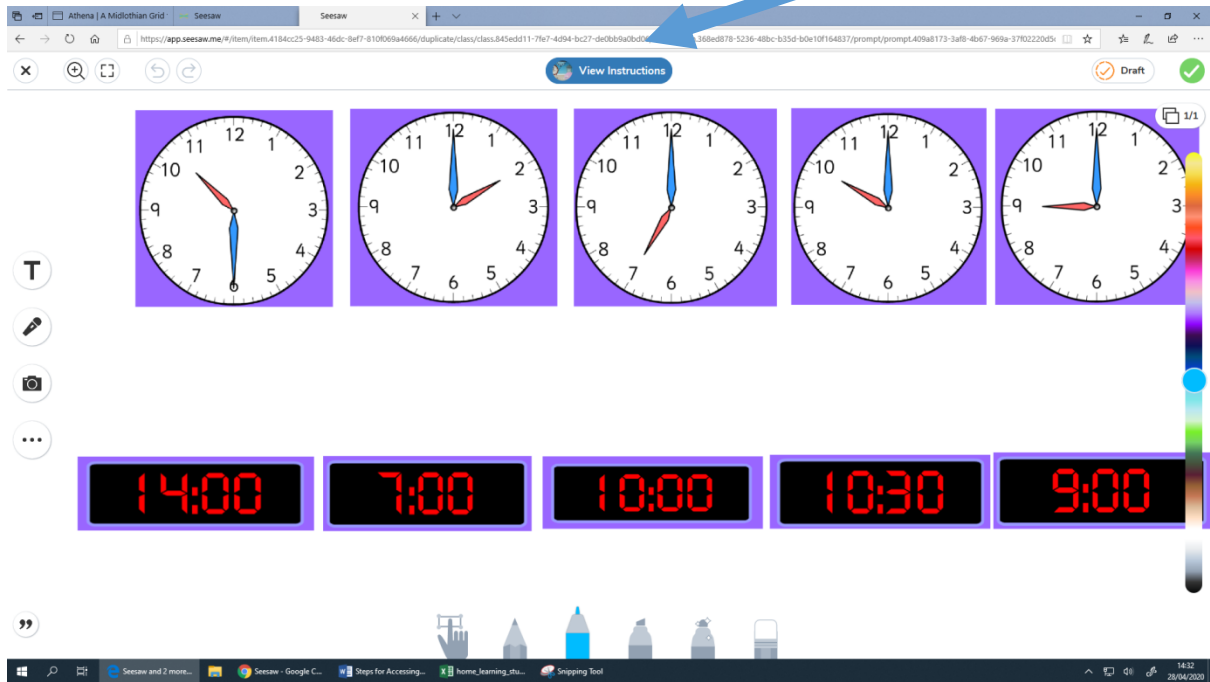
To complete the activity press the green button
