

### What Learning Looks Like in P3/4

#### Literacy

Most of us have made excellent progress in reading, with many moving up the levels Read Write Inc., and even more have moved onto the Reading Comprehension Programme. We will keep doing speed sound lessons and learning new sounds that we might not know.

We have an exciting term of Space themed work in our Big Writing lessons where we will review old skills and learn some new ones. We are focusing on our sentence writing and remembering to use our VCOP skills to punctuate sentences in every piece of writing.

#### Numeracy

We have a busy term of maths topic, learning about Data Handling and Time. We will keep using Sumdog and Topmarks games to consolidate our numeracy skills in different areas including fractions, missing numbers and sequences, addition and subtraction, multiplication and number work. We will learn to double and half numbers effectively, along with other skills. We have made some brilliant progress in fractions so far this term, a skill many of us found tricky, so keep up the great work!

### Health and Wellbeing

Mr Cook is keeping us healthy with his fabulous PE lessons in athletics, practising our running, jumping and throwing skills every Friday. Mr Wood is also delivering PE and HWB on Tuesdays, covering similar topics as preparation for a possible sports day. We will also be learning about caring for living things and their needs.

#### IDL

Our Topic this term is on Space, and so far most of the class have really been enjoying it. We have made contact with a Space expert who will hopefully answer any questions about Space that we don't cover in our topic. We are excited to borrow a meteorite learning box that will help us learn more about outer space and some of the things that are out there.
