Thank you for your continued support and cooperation.


Seasonal Information

What Learning Looks Like in P2 Literacy

Read, Write, Inc sessions continue to take place daily from Monday-Thursday. We have recently regrouped for Read, Write Inc meaning some children now leave the classroom to attend their Read, Write, Inc sessions. All children continue to work hard on their reading and writing skills through these small group sessions with an adult, focussing on recognising sounds, blending words and completing a mixture of writing and handwriting activities.

We continue working on our writing programme 'Big Writing' and are now working on our second Mini Mission focussing on our class novel 'The Owl Who is Afraid of the Dark' and our IDL topic 'Materials'. During this mission we will focus on forming our sentences correctly, introducing new vocabulary such as adjectives to up-level our writing and using connectives.

Numeracy

This term in numeracy we continue to focus on our number formation, addition and subtraction. We have also started looking at place value, ordering and sequencing numbers and division. Throughout the week, we continue to cover number

structures, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.



Our numeracy lessons take the form of a carousel in which the children visit 4 stations— Teacher Time, Independent Task, Interactive Game and Exploratory Play—

In Maths we will be focusing on measure and time.

PE & Health and Wellbeing

This term, we will continue to have PE on Wednesday afternoons in the school gym hall in which we will focus on Fitness and Gymnastics. Children are encouraged to come to school wearing suitable clothing and footwear for running around in - due to COVID restrictions, we are unable to get changed for PE within school at this time.

IDL

This term our topic will be materials. We will learn all about the different materials around us and their purpose. Through doing so we will explore the different properties of materials building on our vocabulary as we begin to discuss them. This topic will include a range of stimulating activities covering many curricular areas, such as literacy, technologies, science and geography.

Class Expectations and Rewarding Positive Behaviour

This term we continue to follow the rules agreed on our class charter, as well as our

three main classroom rules Ready, Respectful and Safe, to ensure a positive classroom environment for all. We continue to use our behaviour chart to monitor behaviour and reward positive choices. We also continue to have a Secret Student everyday and strive to fill our Recognition Board each week to earn a treat on a Friday.
