Numeracy & Maths

Our Numeracy and Maths areas of learning are as follows:

- Number Structure (Monday) place value to 9-digits
- Maths (Monday) building 3D shapes
- Multiplication and Division (Tuesday) dividing using the bus stop method
- Algebraic Thinking (Wednesday) solving 2-step equations
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages (Thursday) equivalent fractions
- Addition and Subtraction (Friday) visualising subtraction problems

Seesaw / Digital Technology

If you require a login code for Seesaw for either you or your child please do let me know. P7 are posting their work regularly on Seesaw. We use Chromebooks for learning across the curriculum and specific digital literacy skills are taught. The P7s are very confident with using Google Classroom.

For Book Week Scotland we used Ghostbusters as our inspiration. On the Monday we read a picture book adaption of the 1984 original movie. For STEM we created our own proton packs using recycled materials. For Writing we created our own Ghostbusters stories.
