What Learning Looks Like in P2 Literacy

During RWI the children will work on their reading and writing skills through small group sessions with an adult, games which focus on sounds and blending and a mixture of writing and handwriting activities and worksheets.

We have started our new whole school writing programme PM Writing, The first part of this programme is to focus on descriptive writing and in P2R we have been doing this orally and will then move onto written work.

Numeracy

In numeracy we will be focusing on strategies to help us with numbers, number bonds to 10 and 20 and eventually up to 100, halving and doubles, and using a number line or manipulatives for both subtraction and addition. Throughout the week, we will focus on the five domains which cover number structures, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.

Children will learn though whiteboard activities, table top games, written tasks and smart board games.

In Maths we will be focusing on measurement and

time.

Our topic up until Christmas is 'Our Planet Earth'. Throughout our topic we will be learning about continents, oceans, extreme earth, climate and different cultures and traditions.
