- Additional Learning Assistant (20 hours) to support implementation of 1:1 numeracy targeted intervention.
- Ready Set Go - Supports for learners for P4 and P7 to achieving expected level in Numeracy.
- Additional resources to increase engagement.

Increasing Attendance

- To reinstate our morning toast club. Funding supports the food supplies and staff to supervise this.

Cost of the School Day

- Reduce the overall cost of P7 camp for all learners
- Support purchasing new uniforms, PE equipment, swimwear, skiing gloves/socks and personal care. Replenish when required
- Additional technology equipment to support charging of chromebooks in school.
- Support attending extra-curricular clubs

Targeted Approaches to Raising Attainment in Literacy

- ASG Literacy Principal Teacher focusing on targeted interventions in P4 and P7 for reading and writing
- ASG PT to support moderation activities at all levels in ASG schools through literacy champions.
- Additional Learning Assistant (20 hours) trained in interventions to ensure continuity across week.
- Nessy Spelling, online literacy support for 30 children across the school who have literacy barriers.

Health and Wellbeing

- Play Therapy for individual learners as well as weekly drop in sessions for P7s
- Seasons for Growth for learners managing change and loss
- Gold and Gray Football - P4 group and individuals
- Sensory resources for Nest supporting enhanced class
