### **Rosewell Primary School FAQs**

### How many classrooms are in the school?

Seven in session 2021-2022, we will have eight in 2022-2023

#### What are class sizes?

National guidance is up to:

25 children at P1 stage

30 children at P2 and P3

33 children at P4-P7 33

25 children in composite classes

In Rosewell Primary at the start of session 2021-2022 we had a P1, P2/1, P3/2, P4/3, P5/4, P6 and a P7 class.

## Are the lunches split across the school?

Yes: P3/4, P4/5, P6 and P7 are on first sitting at 12.30am

P1, P2/1 and P3/2 children are on second sitting at approx. 12/45am

## How can parents get involved?

Volunteering in school and by joining the Parent Council. More information is found in our School Handbook.

### Will all P1s be in the same class?

There will be a P1 and a P2/1 class.

### What games are in the playground?

We are fortunate to have a large playground. With a grassy areas as well as tarmac for ball games. We have various playground toys as well as a 'quiet area' for those children who want to sit and have some quiet time. P7 buddies usually spend the first few weeks supporting P1 in the playground.

# Will days be similar to the nursery or straight into learning sounds etc?

We spend the first week or so settling in and then start introducing sounds and build up other curricular areas.

# Will they be in for full days or half days?

We will be full-time from Day 1. If you think that this will not work for you or your child, please contact us.

# How will playtime work?

We will have staggered playtime initially

#### Will children need PE kits?

Yes, at the start of next session we will be returning to full school uniform (we have had a relaxed approach to this) and we will be changing for PE. A bag with a t-shirt, shorts and soft gym shoes is needed but not straight away. Class teachers will advise you. P1s usually start changing for PE later in the first term.
