



Literacy & English

Writing – Exploring seasons non-fiction report.

Reading – Our class novel 'The Last Firefox' which we will use to develop vocabulary, and for reading comprehension. Learners will work in appropriate groups to support phonics and reading (Read, Write, Inc) or Book Talk in a levelled group.

Spelling- Focus on a sound for a two-week cycle as well as working on irregular word lists

Talking and Listening – Continuing to use talking partners on a regular basis.

Learners will also work on an informal group presentation as part of IDL.

Numeracy & Maths



NUMERACY

- Numerals and Sequences – Sequences in 2s, 10s and 5s (3 and 4 for some)
- Place Value and Structure – number stories (for example $100 = 40 + 50 + 7 + 3$) and rounding to the nearest 10 and 100
- Addition and Subtraction – linking materials (dienes, bunching straws) to 100 squares with empty number line.
- Multiplication and Division – continuing to use materials to solve division problems. Using images to write sums. $\text{☺} \text{☺} \text{☺} \text{☺} = 16$

MATHS

- Shape 2D and 3D Increasing knowledge and features of shapes and becoming familiar with the terms side, face, edge, vortex and angle.
