

Literacy & English

Writing – Guided narrative writing centred around the book 'Flood' by Alvaro F. Villa. P5 will then write their own independent narrative story (with a disaster theme) using the techniques and structure explored during the guided writing lessons.

Reading – Book talk based around group reading books. Guided and independent reading comprehension based around class text 'Where the River Runs Gold and 'The Lost Whale'. Developing skills to analyse a text and use evidence to support comprehension answers.

Spelling – Fortnightly spelling patterns with daily opportunities to practise spelling.

Grammar- adverbials, personification, and speech (linked to writing)

Talking and Listening – Book Talk and class discussions. P5 Gather Round centred around anti-bullying.

Numeracy & Maths

Numeracy Focus:

- 4 operations (+, -, x and ÷) Focus on strategies to help work out problems.
- Fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Basic Maths Facts – quick recall of number bonds and multiplication and division facts.

Maths Focus:

- Money – budgeting and profit and loss.
- Measure – perimeter and area.
