Listening and Talking

Keeping a focus on listening to others, and following instructions, becoming more confident in having classroom discussions engaging all learners and deepening our understanding.

Reading

RWInc – continue working on building our familiar sounds and build and extend our vocabulary, and increase our awareness of different spelling patterns. This allows us to become more confident with a variety of different texts and books.

Book Talk – Skills to gain a deeper understanding of different texts, and express our understanding and ideas through talking and listening, engaging in deeper discussions

Writing

Continue Write Stuff framework, focusing on persuasive writing, using the book *The Day the Crayons Quit*. Create our own persuasive letter. Link into our topic by creating a persuasive letter about how we can help the environment.



Numeracy & Maths



Numeracy

Multiplication and division, working on the speed in our recall of multiplication and division facts, mainly focusing on 2, 5 and 10 times tables, and begin introducing other numbers.

Strategies: using arrays – with counters dot cards, skip counting, and also including worded problems and abstract numbers to be able to relate the similarities with multiplication and division.

Maths

Measurement in maths including measuring heights, lengths, weights and volume, using different instruments and resources to relate these measurements and be able to compare measurements finding out which would be the heaviest. How to record different types of measurement using the correct notation such as mm, cm, and grams.

Health & Well Being

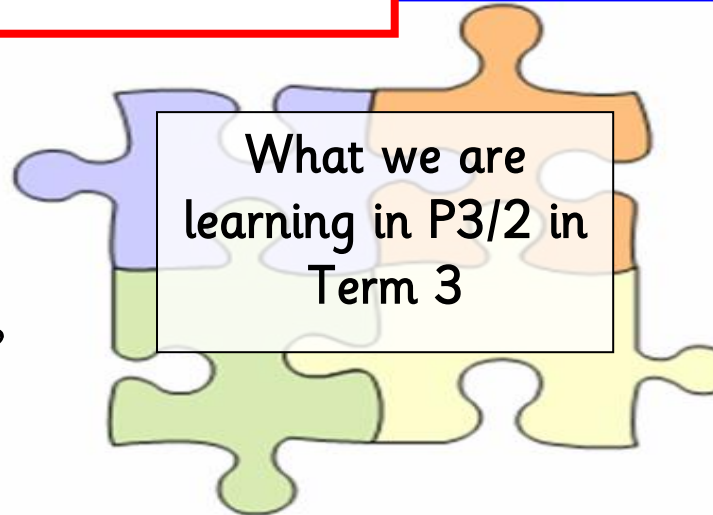
