Reading & Spelling: All Following the Read Write Inc phonics and spelling programme.

Numeracy

P1

- Number processes (addition and subtraction within 10 and 20) Grouping and sharing.

P2

- Place value of numbers up to and including 3 digit numbers

- Number processes of addition, subtraction, grouping and sharing (multiplication and division)

Maths

Position and Movement: to describe simple journeys using positional language, utilising technology including using Sphero indi robot vehicles.

Measurement: to use a range of non-standard units to investigate measure of length, mass & capacity. Linking this to our IDL.
