LITERACY

Reading

Pick one of your favourite books to read for fun. You could read to or with someone in your family. Or, try Audible free to listen to a new story: <https://stories.audible.com/start-listen>

Comprehension

Comprehension sheets are in class materials. These range from levels B to G, just like we have used for homework before.

Levels F and G are a challenge.

You should be able to fill in your answers directly on the sheet on the computer in a PDF reader. If not, you can print them out.

Writing

Write a letter or card to a family member, friend, or neighbour. You could write a kind message asking how they are and including what is happening in your life.

Alternatively, you could make a video to sent to family and friends.

NUMERACY

Revision

Select a numeracy revision sheet from within the Class materials folder on Teams.

These are organised in the 1st and 2nd levels.

The new packs of sheets should allow you to fill in your answers straight onto the page in Adobe PDF reader.

You can try the level you have worked on before or challenge yourself with higher level.

Heinemann Maths

There are also folders of Heinemann maths practise worksheets similar to the kind of sheets we have used as class homework in the past.

The new sets of sheets should also allow you to edit straight onto to the page.

These grouped in into folders based on 1st and 2nd level, then by topics, including:

Whole number, additional and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions, depending on the level.
