## histoire


Can you create a timeline detailing the key events in French History from 1000 – 2000?

The Menu should be designed and branded with your café / restaurant name and logo.


There should also be a children's menu and a puzzle sheet or booklet for children to complete.

Paris is home to a number of famous galleries including the Louvre, the Musee D'Orsay and the Rodin Museum.


What famous art works can you find and copy? Who did the originals?
