Covid Updates

Thank you for supporting our school to be a safe place by wearing face coverings at pick up and drop off and by distancing from other households.

Pupils are now permitted to mix with each other in their classrooms and will have more opportunities to participate in group learning activities. Classes are not yet permitted to mix across the school.

Classes can now mix outdoors and no longer have designated areas within the playground

Lunches

We can confirm that P1-4 learners will now have the opportunity to choose their meal at lunchtime. This means that there is no longer a requirement for parents to complete the online survey each week. We thank you for your support during this interim period. The lunch menu will be issued to P1-4 parents for your information. If you wish to opt out of a school lunch on a Friday, please email the school office. This will help us to reduce the amount of waste.

Annual Data Returns/Medication

Many thanks to those of you who have already returned your annual data form and any relevant medical information. If you have not yet returned this information, we encourage you to do so as a matter of urgency.

Medication

If your child requires any medication (including inhalers) while at school, please ensure that you have completed the relevant medication form. These are available from Mrs Howat at the school office.

As per our administration of medication policy, we cannot administer this medication without parental consent. Please also ensure all medication sent to school is in date.

At this time PE changing rooms remain closed and children will not be encouraged to change for PE. We advise that on the days children have PE, they come to school dressed in sportswear.

Nut-Free Snacks

Due to severe nut allergies at our school, please do not send your child to school with snacks or lunch items containing nuts. This includes, but is not limited to, Kinder Buenos, Nutella, Daim bars and peanut butter. Please note that any snacks with nuts in them will be sent home with the child.

Breakfast Club

We are delighted to inform you that breakfast club will officially recommence on Monday 23^{rd} August following an update from the local authority.

Breakfast club is available to all learners from Nursery to Primary 7 and will be free of charge due to our partnership with the Gregg's Foundation. Toast and cereal will be available. Please note that in order to comply with current restrictions, pupils will be required to sit in their classes.



Breakfast Club opens at 8am and children should enter via the main office door. No pre booking is required. Last entry into breakfast club is 8.35am.

Uniform

It is so lovely to see our learners back in full school uniform. Thank you to parents and carers for all your support with this.

Please be reminded that this consists of:

P1: A maroon polo shirt, school jumper, grey trousers/skirt/pinafore, black/white socks and black shoes. A white shirt and tie can be worn if preferred

P2-6 A white shirt, tie, maroon v-necked jumper/cardigan, grey trousers/skirt/pinafore, black/white socks and black shoes.

P7: A white shirt, tie, maroon v-necked jumper/cardigan/leavers' hoody, grey trousers/skirt/pinafore, black/white socks and black shoes.
