Litter Picks:

Classes will be involved in organised Litter Picks – in and around our school grounds and woodland area. The activity has been fully risk assessed to ensure learners' safety. Disposable gloves and litter pickers will be provided and learners will not be expected to touch items of litter with their bare hands. Close adult supervision will be in place at all times. We ask that learners wear warm clothing and sturdy footwear, eg: boots, trainers or wellies on their allocated Litter Pick day.
