In consultation with Primary 6 and 7, we have written a Digital Device Charter to inform the best use of our devices.

Be Ready

- Make sure that your device is charged and ready to use
- If you take the device home, make sure to bring your device back to school the next day
- Make sure you are only accessing the programme or website that your teacher has instructed you to access

Be Respectful

- Do not touch other pupil's devices without permission
- Only access your device when asked to do so
- Put your device away when instructed to do so
- Only take photographs or share images using your device if you have permission
- Do not use your device to send inappropriate or disrespectful messages to others

Be Safe

- If a website or message does not feel right, tell an adult
- Understand that your username and password is private and should not be shared with anyone
- Keep food and drink away from your device
- Always store your device in the case that was provided with it
- Carefully carry your device in your schoolbag when transporting it between home and school
- Do not share personal information online
- Ensure charging cables are not a trip hazard
