Breakfast Club Arrangements

Here at St David's we run a free Breakfast Club which is open to all families. We were exceptionally proud to provide 4335 free breakfasts between 20th August 2018 to 18th January 2019! The Greggs Foundation support this free club which provides a hot breakfast daily. This important meal ensures our children are ready for learning when school begins.

Please note that this is a free, optional service available for all. Mrs Corbett works exceptionally hard to ensure a smooth running of the club and Mrs Jones is released from her office role to support the administration and ensure quality play opportunities for the children.

Breakfast Club runs from 8.15am to 8.40am. The children are well prepared each morning to make their way into the playground at 8.40am and have a clear understanding about how to keep themselves safe ahead of school beginning at 8.50am. All of this information has been communicated to families through our school website, Twitter feed and newsletters.

I would however like to reiterate the following points to ensure absolute clarity if you wish for your child to attend this optional, free service.

- children remain in the school hall until 8:40am when they may go out to their area of the school grounds to play
- children are escorted to the playground by older pupils
- children attending Breakfast Club remain in the school hall during inclement weather.
- there is no supervision in the playground before Breakfast Club or before school
- children are only supervised in the playground during morning break and lunchtime periods.

If you have concerns relating to the above arrangements, I suggest that you find alternative childcare/ drop off arrangements for school.
