

LEARNING FROM HOME IN PRIMARY 1



Phonics & Reading

- Practice forming some of your sounds on a piece of paper. You could rainbow-write them in different colours across the page. Check Seesaw for the videos previously posted to check you are forming the letters correctly
- Use your sound cards from our Home Learning to practice Fred Talking and blending words. You can also use them to spell and make words. You can practise writing words too. You could rainbow write them, make them with playdough, type them etc. and draw pictures to match
- Share a story with an adult and say what you liked/disliked about it. Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story or your favourite character.

Numeracy and Mathematics

- Make a number poster by picking a number and thinking of different ways to represent it i.e *All about 5*
 - Draw 5 objects

- Show what 5 looks like on a dice (dot pattern)
 - 5 tally marks
 - 5 in a 10 Frame
 - 5 fingers
 - Addition sums to make 5
 - Subtraction sums to make 5
- Measure different objects around your house using pens/pencils/lego e.g. My dining table is 10 pencils long

Social Studies / Expressive Arts

Create a symmetrical picture of a Butterfly using lots of colour and pattern like the one in the story of 'The Hungry Caterpillar'

Health and Wellbeing

We have been learning about the healthy food plate. Look at the food you have in your house and try and sort it into groups – carbohydrates, dairy, protein, fruit and vegetables and high in fats and sugar.

RE

Read the Story of Noah's Arc and draw a picture of the different animals that went on the boat. Look up the

song 'The animals went in two by two' on You Tube and practice singing it.
