Literacy and English

Grammar look at the list and learn what some of the terminology means e.g. what is a synonym

	Revisit singular and plural nouns
	Use similes and metaphors
	Introduce more complex contractions (wouldn't, couldn't, won't, doesn't)
	Introduce apostrophe for possession
	Homophones two, to too, your, you're, where, wear, were
	Revise past, present and future tense
	Use full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas in lists, ellipsis consistently
	Continue to experiment with ellipsis, inverted commas, dashes, brackets
	Identify and change verb tenses

	Can use a comma to put additional information into a sentence. (eg: The dog, yelping in pain, licked his paw.)
	Understand that adverbs and adverbial phrases can be used to open sentences eg. Quietly, he opened the door/ Holding his breath, he opened the door
	Further extend range of connectives (see VCOP triangle)
	Antonyms and Synonyms
	Can use speech marks in a simple sentence
	Develop the use of paragraphs and sections in a variety of writing and understand why these are used
	Comparatives and Superlatives
	Use a thesaurus to enhance writing
	Recognise subject and object in a sentences
	Can use a dictionary and order words to the third letter
	Use a variety of strategies to check spellings e.g. electronic spell checker, google
	Proof read own pieces of work
	Be able to explain the effect of a prefix or suffix on a word e.g (un,dis,mis,im)
