- maintain strong links with Father Andrew Garden, parish priest of St David's, Dalkeith and St Luke's and St Anne's, Mayfield
- offer a broad and varied curriculum across subjects from ELC to P7
- focus on active learning approaches working to engage pupils in their learning
- provide a varied and creative approach to Support for Learning responding to the diverse needs across our school
- welcome and support pupils with a wide range of additional support needs, social and emotional needs and health care requirements
- have reduced the cost of the school day, offering a wide range of inputs e.g. healthy snack boxes available in every classroom

- to have adopted our local woodland area and to explore citizenship and sustainability themes through this unique environment
- provide regular opportunities for families to participate in their child's learning
- have achieved our Silver Sports Scotland Award (September 2019)
- have maintained our Green Flag award from Eco Schools Scotland (February 2021)
- have an active and supportive Parent Council who work tirelessly to support the school and local community

What happens if my child is successful and granted a place?

Following confirmation of your child's place at St David's (around April 2023), you will receive an invite to participate in a number of transition events with your child (these could be virtual and/ or in person). These will generally take place from mid May until early June and for some families, run through the summer and beyond to ensure a strong partnership approach and positive start to your child's Primary 1.
