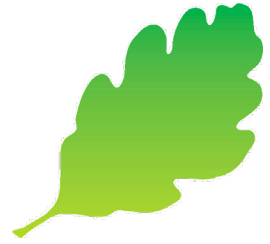

Dear Parent/Carer

As we near the end of the first term I would like to thank you for your ongoing support and patience as we continue to manage the impact of the pandemic on the day-to-day running of our schools and at times your child's education.
