Tomorrow (Thursday) they will lead us in celebrating the Feast of the ascension of Our Lord at Mass in Our Lady Church at 10.30am. Families are very welcome to join us for this Holyday of Obligation. We will have our own Crowning of Mary celebration in Assembly this Friday and the children are invited to bring flowers for a small Altar beside the statue in the school.

**MILK ORDER AND PAYMENTS** If you would like your child to have milk when we return in August, this needs to be ordered and paid for in advance. The cost for the period from **August to October** is **£6.97** and must be paid using **Parent Pay.** If you are in receipt of certain benefits and think you are entitled to **Free School Meals**, this also entitles you to free school milk. It is a gateway benefit that can also help with costs for trips and school camp, clothing etc. If you need support in applying for this, please do let office staff know – they are happy to help.

**SCHOOL UNIFORM** Over the past few years we have relaxed our school uniform policy to really only expect the children to wear a burgundy jumper or cardigan either with or without the school badge. Joggers and leggings are acceptable to wear in school and I know many parents like to have pinafores and summer school dresses – ours would be either pale blue or burgundy. We have increasing numbers of children not wearing any uniform, and often on a Friday. Jeans should not be worn to school and children should refrain from wearing jewellery.

We have a uniform exchange if anyone has uniform in good condition that can be passed on to other families – just ask at the school office. Please hand in any uniform you have that is still in good condition – please wash it first – as stocks are beginning to run low.
