

Information for Parents - Outline Plan for Learning and Teaching

Topic / Project Title: The Weather

LiteracyReading

Primary 2 will continue to get a reading book as homework which will be read aloud in class twice a week. In groups the children will be revising their Key Stage Words to increase their fluency, confidence and understanding. They will also engage in reading comprehension tasks which will answer questions of text they have read.

Spelling

We will be continuing to follow the Jolly Grammar programme for spelling. The class will focus on a new sound every week. These will be posted on SeeSaw each week if you would like to practice them at home.

Writing

Primary 2 will continue to do weekly writing lessons which will focus on descriptive writing. We will be covering various other aspects of writing throughout the year following our 'Talk 4 Writing' programme.

Numeracy

This period we will continue to

- Develop and use different strategies for addition and subtraction
- Focus of recognising, ordering, sequencing and comparing numbers up to and beyond 100
- And will begin to learn strategies for solving basic multiplication sums.

Maths

We will be learning about measure where the children will be estimating and measuring the height, weight and length of different objects.

Topic

Primary 2 will be learning about the weather for their topic this period. The children will be learning about

- Different types of weather
- The impact that weather has on living things
- Creating and using weather instruments
- Climate and adaptation
